
Dear Mr. Crabtree:

A session on aspects of Lithic Technology will be chaired by Gerald A. Holley and myself at the forthcoming Society for American Archaeology meetings in Van Couver. The meetings will be held between April 23 and April 26, 1979.

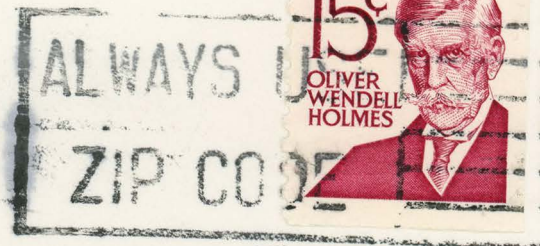
