DEAR MR. CRABTREE:

IN A RECENT TELEPHONE CONVERSATION WITH EARL SWANSON AT THE IDAHO STATE UNIVERSITY MUSEUM I WAS TOLD THAT YOU WOULD NOT BE HOME FOR SOME TIME BUT THAT WE MIGHT REACH YOU AT THE ABOVE ADDRESS.

WE ARE TRYING TO LOCATE ADDITIONAL COLOR SLIDES SHOWING THE VARIOUS STAGES THAT WERE SO GRAPHICALLY ILLUSTRATED IN YOUR FILM ON FLINTKNAPPING. I AM TRYING TO PUT TOGETHER A SLIDE SHOW OF TEN OR TWELVE MINUTES LENGTH AND SO WOULD LIKE FORTY OR FIFTY SLIDES TO CHOOSE FROM, IF THAT MANY ARE AVAILABLE.

I WILL ALSO SEND A COPY OF THIS LETTER TO YOUR HOME IN CASE YOU HAVE LEFT MEXICO. IF YOU CAN CONTACT ME AS SOON AS POSSIBLE, WE WOULD APPRECIATE IT VERY MUCH.
