Thank you for your letter of Feb. 21st regarding artifact found at your home.

It is impossible to answer your question without seeing the artifact for analysis. One must consider the material, the cutting edge, the sequence of flake removal, etc. to be sure the piece is genuine and not something produced by natural forces.

From the drawing, all I can say is that it looks like a blade-like flake and could well be a primary flake removed from a larger piece or simply debitage.

I am sorry that I cannot be of more help, but one must actually see the material to make an analysis. Thank you for your interest and for writing.
