It has been suggested that a topic of interest for special consideration at the Plains Conference this fall might be aboriginal butchering techniques.


This letter, which is being sent to all of the individuals listed below, is one of inquiry to determine whether or not special arrangements should be made for a consideration of this topic at the Conference.
