Lawrence can be reached directly by the Union Pacific or Santa Fe Railroads, and by Continental Trailways or Greyhound Bus Lines. Air transportation is indirect. It is most convenient via Kansas City Municipal Airport, a one hour drive from Lawrence. Transportation from Kansas City Municipal Airport to Lawrence will be available on Wednesday, November 26. Individuals planning on flying should supply the conference chairman with flight numbers and arrival times, as soon as these are known, so transportation from Kansas City can be arranged. Cars for the trip to Lawrence will be available at the airport at regular intervals, scheduled to minimize waiting.
