Dear Sirs:

Having been employed by you on a "for hire" basis to prepare an article of 5,000 words on the Technology of Stone Tools for which when accepted, I am to receive a fee of \$200.00 I hereby agree that, upon payment of the above fee, all rights therein for use within the Dictionary of Prehistory shall become the property of Charles Scribner's Sons, including, without limitation, copyright and all renewals and extensions thereof. Charles Scribner's Sons shall have full control over the content and use of this article.

In the event that the article is selected for republication by Charles Scribner's Sons in either a clothbound trade edition or a paperbound college edition, I understand that an additional compensation of 10% of the list price of the trade edition, and 7½% of the list price of the college edition, on net sales of all copies will be paid to Dr. Earl Swanson, Jr. Idaho State University, the Museum, Pocatello, Idaho. In the event of republication of the articles by Charles Scribner's Sons in combination with another article or articles, it is understood that his additional compensation will be the pro rata share of 10% and 7½%, respectively. Accountings of such additional compensation will be provided semi-annually, reflecting sales from February 1st to July 31st, and August 1st to January 31st, and payable four months after the end of the accounting period.
