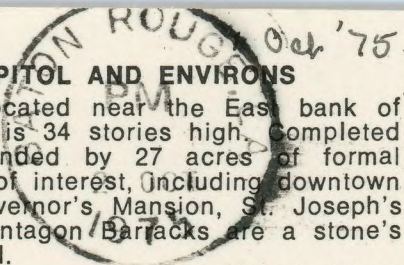




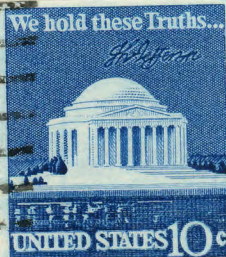
LOUISIANA CAPITOL AND ENVIRONS
