Dear Mr. Crabtree:

It is my privilege and pleasure to confirm your selection as the Northwest Federation of Mineralogical Societies' Honorary Award Winner for the AFMS Scholarship Foundation for 1974. My sincere congratulations to you! Mr. Joe Bybee, AFMS Scholarship Director for the Northwest Federation notified you of this selection in his letter, dated Jan. 15, 1974. As mentioned in his letter, presentation of your Honorary Award will be made at the Convention Banquet in Forest Grove, Oregon on Aug. 10, 1974.

With this Honorary Award goes the privilege of selecting a School within the recognized boundaries of the Northwest Federation, and assisting that School in the selection of a Student who is to receive a Grant from us to help to achieve his, or her, educational goal. This will be for the school years 1974-75 and 1975-76. At present the Scholarship Grant is in the amount of \$750.00 for each of the two years, a total of \$1500.00.

Mr. Bybee has given you most of the information you will need. The AFMS Foundation regulations require that beneficiary students should be:

1. Working toward a Masters or Doctors Degree.
2. Subjects must be in any of the Earth Sciences.
3. Either men or women students are acceptable.
4. The Student need not be in actual want, but should be reasonably in need of this assistance, and worthy of it.

Selection of the Students has usually been made during the spring when they are being interviewed for Graduate School.


