I would love to see some of the blades you mention, for I am sure that all blades do not fit the Corbiac definition. This is a very specialized site in France and, of course, all blades are not the same.

I am sorry that I do not have any obsidian or antler to send you for, due to the rockhounds, we are having a real problem getting enough lithic material for our school here. Have had to import some from Mexico. However, I think it would be better if you did not use obsidian but, rather, used the materials native to your area. In this way you can more accurately duplicate the blades in question.
