deer antler hammers, and Mr. Tixie's technique to making blades. Of course my technique is not so complete.

I would like to say I will be happy to make an interview K.M.V.T. T.V., however my English is not so good and it will be very difficult to make the interview. If I mastered one of the peculiar techniques of Prehistoric Japan I would not hesitate about introducing it, through a Japanese Translator. Unfortunately I have not yet mastered compleatly even the Yubetsu Technique in Hokkaido.

Therefore I learn English, reflected on my experience with Prof. Bordes. But it make slow progress like a tortoise walking. So I am afraid it will be difficult to discuss flintknapping techniques with you. I am now reading your report "Notes on Experiments in Flintknapping 4" under an American teacher of English.

I am looking foreward to meeting you in Twin Falls on November 21st.
