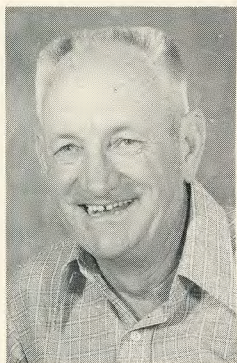


About the artist . . .



Earl McAdams, a Twin Falls city fireman for 27 years—now retired—spends much of his time on his western sculpture and nature scenes. Earl was born in Billings, Montana, in 1911 and lived in Montana, Wyoming and South Dakota.

He had no art training, but as a child it seemed a natural thing for him to make his life-like toys with mud or clay. He was also very adept with "scissor painting" or cutting silhouettes of whatever he chose. His love for horses came from working with them on road construction in his early years.

Now the old West comes to life as Earl is working with wax and has them cast in bronze in "limited" editions at Alpine Bronze Works, Missoula, Montana.

He is a member of the Art Guild of Magic Valley. His work has been seen at art shows in Sun Valley and Twin Falls, as well as Herrett's Arts and Science Museum, Twin Falls Bank & Trust, La Plata Gallery, Taos, New Mexico; Pink Corral, Jackson Hole, Wyoming.

They are on display any time at Bromund Art Gallery, Virginia City, Nevada, or at his home studio, Twin Falls, Idaho.
