Not since Stevenson's Doctor Jekyll and Mr. Hyde has the theme of double personality been so convincingly handled. There are fights and battle, folklore, science, mystery, exotic description, high adventure, and intense human interest, in this typical Merritt novel, the high water mark of his power.
