Now that the annual trip down the Clearwater River has been completed, I presume that you have some pertinent observations and reports to make on some of your experiences. I am particularly eager to know about the inspection made at the Bruces Eddy site and whether there was much opposition on the part of fish and wildlife enthusiasts.

You probably have been reading about the defeat of the medicare plan in the Senate and the President's announcement that he will make this an issue in the November campaign. My correspondence would indicate that there is overwhelming sentiment against this medicare plan under the Social Security System.

I have been checking developments on the House side, particularly regarding the Omnibus bill. I understand that Cliff Davis, Congressman from Tennessee, who is Chairman of the Public Works Subcommittee, is engaged in the primary campaign, which accounts for some of the delay here.
