SUBJECT: DWORSHAK AREA - RESOLUTION

The Idaho State Board of Land Commissioners, by unanimous vote at its August 12, 1969 meeting, reiterated its position of being opposed to any further taking of private lands by the Federal Government in the Dworshak Reservoir area. Should additional lands be needed for wildlife habitat improvement or for any other purpose, the acquisition should be through a trading of Federal lands for private lands to prevent further diminishing of the tax base in Clearwater county and the State of Idaho.
