Enclosed are the snapshots of the Dent place I promised you. My sister and I stopped at the dam again on the way back and saw the name L.R. Vanairsdale, Spokane, Wa. on the register with the remark "Born at Dent Idaho 1895, how dare you flood my birthplace!"

We thought it quite a coincidence we were there the same day after having read that name in the paper you still have, saying his mother had visited grandma Dent. We decided to call him up after we got home. He said he would go on up to your cafe on his next trip.

On picture #1, the old log cabin saloon is at the far left, beyond the breezeway. The vine-covered rootcellar shows at the right of the back porch. The house faces the present road. I'm sorry I couldn't find a picture showing the front. Picture #2 is taken from the poplars by the old spring in the upper field and shows the old blacksmith shop beyond the front of the house, just above the "hairpin" turn in the road where only an old fence is now. The driveway was between the blacksmith shop and the house.
