

## Engineers Map Snake River Storage Plans

The "main elements" of the Army Engineers' storage proposals for the middle Snake river will be presented at a public hearing at Orofino Nov. 20, Col. F. S. Tandy, Walla Walla district engineer, said Tuesday.

In Boise to inspect Lucky Peak dam, Tandy discussed the Orofino hearings with State Reclamation Engineer Mark Kulp.

"We have completed the surveys and are writing the report," he said. "The purpose of the Orofino hearings is to give affected interests an opportunity

to discuss their viewpoint and any information relative to developments proposed for their area."

He said the Engineers would present a study of the "feasible storage projects" for the area between the Clearwater river and Pittsburg Landing.

The embankment at Lucky Peak has been raised to full elevation, he said, and the outlet works will be completed within a year.
