

Benefit Seen From Dams^{SR}

LEWISTON, Idaho, July 2.—Power development on the Clearwater river drainage can do much toward creation of a recreation area for this region, according to A. B. Curtis of Orofino, candidate on the Republican ticket for election to the United States house of representatives. Curtis spoke at a meeting of the Advance Idaho association at the Bollinger hotel.

The Orofino man said he cannot see where the development of power dams on the Clearwater river, such as at Bruce's Eddy, can have any detrimental effect on fish and wildlife. Curtis claimed fish can be planted behind the dam to help develop a large recreation area.
