#### ANNOUNCEMENTS AND PROCEDURES

- All contestants and accompanists must be registered and have a packet of materials including a badge. This badge is good for all performances EXCEPT Saturday night, and is not transferable.
- Lost badges will not be replaced for 24 hours after they are first reported as lost. After that time a charge will be levied for replacement of the badge.
- 3. Each contestant is responsible for finding out when he/she is to play and then to be in the warm-up room at least 30 minutes prior to that time.

  During that time, the contestant must report to the desk in the warm-up room to give the name of the tunes which are to be played in that round.
- 4. The actual procedure of all contests will be as follows:
  - Player #1 will be called to the gym stage just prior to starting time for each contest.
  - 2) Player #2 will follow immediately and wait in the warm-up room by the gym door. Numbers 3, 4 and 5 should be getting warmed up.
  - 3) #1 leaves by the steps at the other end (east) of the stage as soon as he has finished the third tune. Player #2 will come up to the stage then, and will play after he/she is announced.
  - 4) As #2 leaves the gym door to go the stage, #3 will be brought to the gym door to wait. An official will be there to help you at all times.
  - 5) The rest will follow in the same pattern.
- 5. We must observe all building regulations; Smoking will be allowed in the lunch room or outside.

  When smoking in the lunch room, PLEASE use the ash trays. No liquor of any kind or pets will be permitted in the building.
- 6. Do not hesitate to call on anyone wearing an official badge if you need any help. We are anxious to help you have an enjoyable stay in Weiser and to have the best National Oldtime Fiddle Contest ever. Thank you for all you do to help make it so. You are an essential part of the festivities, without you and the fiddling loving people who come to hear you, there would be no contest. Good luck to you, may you perform to the best of your ability and may the best fiddler win!!

# **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- PURPOSE—The original and continuing purpose of the National Oldtime Fiddlers' Contest is to help perpetuate the oldtime fiddling of pioneer America; to help develop a more genuine audience appreciation, understanding and participation; to preserve the oldtime fiddling tunes; to develop and encourage oldtime fiddlers' jam sessions and contest; to permanently record and display the history, relics and mementos of past oldtime fiddlers' art; and to acknowledge the present-day oldtime fiddlers who are helping to preserve the traditional expressions.
- CONTESTS—Seven Contests—GRAND CHAMPION, SENIOR, MEN, LADIES, JUNIOR, JUNIOR-JUNIOR, and SMALL FRY Contest conducted annually. Contestants must be a resident of North America. (Rules available for specific information regarding each Contest.)
- JUDGING—Judging will be done by five (5) qualified judges and the high and low scores for each contestant at each appearance will not be used in calculating total points. Judging will be done by remote and no judge can see any contestant or hear an introduction or commentary. Contestant is identified only by number.
- STOP WATCH—Stop watch will be used in the judging room to enable strict enforcement of the four minute rule.
- CERTIFIED CONTESTS—The National Fiddlers' Certification and Advisory Council, with members from states throughout the nation, certifies local, regional and state contests that qualify. There are many advantages to being certified. Complete information available from the above Council, c/o Chamber of Commerce, Weiser, Idaho 83672. Please notify us of any contests in your area that would like to be certified and complete information will be sent.
- NATIONAL FIDDLERS' HALL OF FAME—It pays tribute and honors oldtime fiddlers of renown and Certified Contest winners throughout the nation. It has established an archives of oldtime fiddling tunes, fiddling papers, notes, and books; to be preserved for future generations. Old fiddles, fiddle mementos and pictures of honored fiddlers are on display. If you have any fiddling relics, mementos, recorded tunes, or information you wish to donate, please contact our committee, c/o Chamber of Commerce, Weiser, Idaho 83672.
- PARADE—This is strictly an "oldtime parade" held on Saturday each year. In keeping with the general aims of our Contest, which is to perpetuate and promote oldtime fiddling, to collect and preserve authentic relics and mementos of the past; we are urging individuals and groups to restore and preserve antique items in the area as a continuing program. Fiddlers and other participants are invited to enter "oldtime" floats. Prizes are awarded in different categories.
- DRESS—In keeping with the theme and purpose of the Contest, everyone is urged to wear "oldtime" dress of pioneer America. Prizes are awarded on this basis. However, since western dress is customary in this community, it will be acceptable if "oldtime" dress is not possible. Persons wearing beach wear, shorts, or sun wear will feel "out of place." Dressy clothing is urged for all evening performances.
- TICKETS—A registered fiddler will receive one pass for personal use plus one guest pass. These passes will allow them entrance into all the shows, except Saturday, when tickets must be purchased. A registered Junior-Junior and Small Fry fiddler will receive one pass for personal use. A Junior-Junior and Small Fry may purchase one Parent Pass if they so desire.

NOTE—All questions, decisions and plans will be governed by the over-all committee on the basis of our Purpose.
