## INSTRUCTIONS TO ROOTERS

The only effective yell is one which is well timed. To be well-timed a yell must be given in perfect unison with the motions of the yell leader. Rules to follow:

1. Know the yells thoroughly.
2. All start hard on the first syllable. Watch the yell leader.
3. Keep together and snap it out at the correct time. Keep with the yell leader's motions.
4. Pitch your voice up and force the sound against your teeth. This will save your voice and give a clearer, sharper tone to the yell.
5. Voice the syllables out. Don't drag them.
