

An Act

Entitled an Act to Establish the  
University of Idaho.

As it enacted by the Legislative  
Assembly of the Territory of Idaho, as  
follows

Section 1.

There is hereby established in  
this Territory, at the Town of Moscow, in  
the County of Latah, an institution of  
learning by the name and style of "The  
University of Idaho."

Section 2.

The government of the University  
shall vest in a Board of Regents, to  
consist of nine members, chosen from  
the Territory at large, which Board the  
Governor shall nominate, and by and  
with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council appoint: The term  
of office of said Regents shall be two  
years from the first Monday in February  
in the year in which appointed.

University not otherwise appropriated,  
The Regent shall receive any pay, mileage  
or per diem, except as above prescribed.

Section 210

This Act shall take effect  
and be in force from and after its  
passage.
