

The above schedule does not include:

1. Wages for the three days the university was closed.
2. Costs of cooperative summer recreation programs, in cooperation with the City of Moscow, established in response to effects of the ash fallout on their programs.
3. Cost of cleaning the outdoor track so that an interrupted resurfacing project may be resumed.
4. Potential accelerated wear and tear on ventilation systems, large motors, office and scientific equipment, vehicles and farm equipment.
5. Potential for short-circuiting of electronic equipment and transformers.
6. Potential lost research opportunities.
7. Lost revenues for auxiliary enterprises and forest nursery operations.
8. Potential effects on enrollment.

Additional efforts which aided cleanup but were not charged to the university include:

1. National Guard assistance in cleaning the campus.
2. City fire department cleaning of flat roofs with their equipment.
