To: Members of the Wildlife Society in Idaho


This is a brief progress report on the organization of the Idaho Chapter of the Wildlife Society. Since writing you in December, we have had two organizational committee meetings and are working toward a general meeting on April 4. At our first meeting, I was elected as general chairman. We have appointed three subcommittees, one with Robert H. Giles, Jr. chairman along with Levi Mohler, Dave Lindsay and Don Klebenow working on a set of By Laws for consideration of the membership.
