SUMMER FIELD MEETING

The Idaho Chapter of the Wildlife Society will sponsor a day-long field meeting on "Problems of Sage-land Wildlife Management."

The meeting will be on Friday, August 20, 1965 at the U. S. Sheep Experiment Station at Dubois, Idaho. The program is being planned and arranged by chapter vice-president Hugh Harper.

Don Klebenow, Ph D candidate at the Idaho Unit, will orient the group on his sage grouse research project and some of the work at the Sheep Station.

The Medicine Lodge Area will then be visited where Duane Pyrah and Gene Gray will demonstrate and discuss radio telemetry techniques involved in their grouse research.

Mr. Bill Radtkey of the Bureau of Land Management will discuss sage brush spraying programs for 1965.

Dr. Edson Fichter's antelope research progress will be presented for the group.

Sites on the Targhee National Forest will be visited and efforts at mountain mahogany rehabilitation will be outlined by Mr. Darrel Flickiger, of the Supervisor's staff of the Targhee National Forest.

As usual, there will be zero business, and maximum study, discussion, and exchange of ideas.
