FINANCIAL STATEMENT

At the close of the 1966 calendar year the Chapter had a balance on hand of \$48.75. Income in 1967, including dues payments for 1968, totaled \$38.00 and expenditures \$13.64. The balance on hand as of January 1, 1968 is \$73.11.

ACCOMPLISHMENTS

The annual business meeting as required by the By-laws of the Chapter was held in April, 1967 in conjunction with the Northwest Section Meeting at Moscow, Idaho.

A summer field meeting was held June 28-30 at Island Park in southeastern Idaho. On the first day, members participated in an early morning goose banding operation on Island Park Reservoir, followed by an afternoon of research and management reports. The second day was a Show-Me trip into the Sand Creek Ranch and Juniper Hills big game management area in Fremont County with Dick Wilson of the Idaho Fish and Game Department serving as chief of party.
