NOMINATIONS AND ELECTION

The Nominating Committee, composed of Hugh Harper, Roger Williams, and Elmer Norberg, submitted the only nominations received. Their slate of candidates appears on the attached ballot.

Chapter By-Laws require two tests for eligibility to vote:

1. Membership in The Wildlife Society as well as Chapter membership (Article III, Section 1). For this election, either 1969 or 1970 Society membership is sufficient.

Society membership costs \$20.00 annually for regular members and \$10.00 for student members. If you wish to join at this time you may include your remittance with your ballot and the Secretary-Treasurer will transmit your application to the Executive Director.

2. Ballots must be returned by December 1, 1969; accompanied by Chapter dues of \$1.00 for 1970, unless already paid (Article V, Section 2).

Chapter membership is \$1.00 annually for students and non-students alike and provides full membership privileges. Associate membership in the Idaho Chapter is available to persons who are not members of The Wildlife Society for \$1.00 annually and allows all privileges except voting and holding office.
