Dear Jim:


I was very pleased to receive your letter this past Saturday and I look forward to producing buckles for the Wildlife Society.

I will honor the \$8.00 each price on an order of 100 bronze buckles, a one-time charge of \$125.00 for art and mold. If you wish to have the buckles serially numbered there is an additional charge of \$.15 each. I highly recommend serial numbering, since it increases both value and appeal. I would expect that you could offer these buckles for around \$14.00.
