Stop 1 - Big Springs - Wildlife Representative



Stop 2 - Poison Creek Summit - Lloyd Ferguson

Stop 3 - Battle Creek Spray - Little Jacks Creek - this stop may be shifted to another area.

Approximately 10 minutes will be allowed per speaker to cover his topic. Wildlife representatives at Stops 3, 5, and 6 will be members from the Wildlife Soc. or Idaho Fish and Game Department. Three stops (Nickle Creek, Trout Springs - Deep Creek Road, ^{Interception} and Juniper Chaining Exclosures) have been eliminated from the previous tour schedule.

II. Committee Assignment Progress

1. Transportation - Five mini buses (total capacity - 100 people) are available from G.S.A. Mini buses will cost 3.85/dy plus 10¢/mile. Charges for the four buses from Boise will run between \$250.00 to \$300.00. Committee needs to check with Marsing Job Corp for additional buses. Overflow can be transported on flat bed trucks.
2. Social Hour - Bill Haight added to the committee
3. Logistics - Wildlife Soc. to assist Tilzey
4. Soliciting Contributions - co-chairmen are Franklin Jones and Woody Benson. Members as previously reported are Larry Young, Jess Wilson, and Dick Bass.
5. Registration - Dave Tidwell added to committee. Advance registration procedures need to be worked out. Tentative registration costs:
 - \$15.00 per man
 - 10.00 for wife
 - 5.00 for individual childThis includes transportation and 6 meals, including the steak barbeque.
6. Tour Signing - Idaho Fish and Game, and Idaho State Land Dept. will assist in posting signs along tour.
7. Publicity - Franklin Jones, Ed Tilzey, Hough Huff, and Dick Lingenfelter were recommended as committeemen in the publicity section. Two colored prints of Juniper Mtn. were passed around as a possible photo for the program cover. Woody Benson suggested and plans were made to prepare a brochure of the tour highlights.
