All,

After going through some of the TWS files I got from Kurt, I found a few things I think we should make decisions on. Please give me your thoughts on the following.

1) National made a request for the Chapter to help support the Calgary conference in a Jan 2004 letter. Any pledge we make is too late to be recognized in the program but I am sure they would like any help that we could provide. They asked for \$500-1000. Do you want to help with the National conference and to what level? I would suggest \$500.

2) National made a request for the Chapter to help endow the Society's policy and outreach efforts. They are seeking to raise \$3M and have raised \$1.3M so far. They would like a \$2500 - 5000 contribution over 5 years, if we can do it. What do you think about \$500/year for this? I think it would be a good thing for us to do provided we are meeting or have met our other obligations which include the scholarship funds, etc. Can the treasurer(s) give us a report on what we are still shooting for on the scholarship funds?

3) The NW section would like records or ours showing the name, address, and email of each person who has paid Section dues at our annual meeting this year. Can the Secretary provide this to them? If so, please send it to Marion Cherry, mbcherry@fs.fed.us or call her at 406-587-6739.

4) National has provided me with 10 copies of their annual report. It is a glossy 4 page short and sweet summary of what they have done and are doing. Each member should have received a copy already. My thoughts are to send copies with a cover letter to ICL, Wilderness Soc., Audubon Soc, AFS, Native Plant Soc, etc just to spread some info around. Do you all have any other ideas on this?

I look forward to your feedback. I am looking for a decision on the \$\$ stuff, so please be sure to tell me yeah or nay so we can get a vote on a decision.
