I have learned that the House Resource and Conservation Committee will soon consider House R.S. 5193 dealing with water withdrawals from Silver Creek. This proposal is to reduce the minimum flows in Silver Creek from 74 CFS to 25 CFS to supply water to trout farming operations. Silver Creek is nationally recognized as a Blue Ribbon Trout Stream and should be managed and preserved to ensure that the Blue Ribbon Status remains.

I understand that the Idaho Department of Water Resources has recommended a minimum stream flow of 74 CFS. I urge that you and your committee strive to keep the 74 CFS minimum stream flow level.
