The Bureau of Land Management has proposed legislation for congressional action that would expand protection for the Birds of Prey Area from the current acreage of 26,000 to over 500,000 acres. The additional protected acres will assure a non-jeopardized prey base in a desert ecosystem which is needed by the raptors in their reproductive efforts.
