RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, this is the third consecutive year the Idaho Legislature has considered land use planning legislation; and

WHEREAS, now is the time for the Idaho Legislature to act on land use planning legislation; and

WHEREAS, the precious heritage that makes the quality of life in Idaho so unique must be preserved and protected; and

WHEREAS, the seven land use planning bills recommended by Governor Cecil D. Andrus advocate locally originated - state assisted land use planning; and

WHEREAS, the Idaho Chapter of the Wildlife Society has for years shown continued interest in the enactment of land use planning legislation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Idaho Wildlife Society hereby urges the executive and legislative leadership of the State of Idaho to give highest priority to the enactment of the seven land use planning bills introduced for consideration by the first regular session of the 43rd Idaho Legislature as recommended by Governor Cecil D. Andrus.
