A special meeting of the Rocky Mountain Trumpeter Swan Population will be convened in Idaho Falls, Idaho on May 24-25, 1994. Details concerning the meeting place were provided earlier by Gary Will and I trust most of you have been properly apprized. Lest some of you were not informed, a copy of Gary's memo is attached.

The meeting was prompted in part by the seemingly limited success of the relocation program, the termination of winter-feeding, the impact of these programs on the Tristate breeding population, the lingering and increasing potential for a winter die-off and the need to develop a coordinated management approach to resolve these issues.

Virtually all government and non-government organizations with a practical, philosophical or legislative interest in this population are being invited to participate. I trust each of you will be prepared to speak with some authority on behalf of your organization with respect to the problems associated with the population and to recommend remedial management action. A typed copy of your comments would be most useful.


