## **ACTION NEEDED**

Society chapters and sections are encouraged strongly to prepare position statements that identify **local** needs for the 1995 Farm Bill. Such statements can be extremely effective in convincing public officials, landowners, and other stakeholders that wildlife should be an important component of agricultural policy. The enclosed documents may be used in preparing your position statement and to communicate wildlife management concerns to your congressional delegation, federal agricultural agency officials, farm and conservation organizations.
