




NFL fans might affectionately know Idaho Vandals football great David Vobora '08 as "Mr. Irrelevant," the last pick in the 2008 NFL draft.





Vandal Snaps: Basketball History







University of Idaho Library network specialist, 1992 graduate and longtime Vandal fan Bill Kerr has played basketball during his lunch hour in Memorial Gym since 1983. For Kerr, the only thing better than the midday break is being in the stands during an idaho basketball game.


"Memorial Gym is my favorite venue," he said. "The noise level in there can get pretty good even with a small crowd."

Kerr started attending the men's games in 1982, and became part of the women's following in 1984. Although he prefers Memorial Gym as a venue, he's witnessed some lofty achievements over the years in both the gym and Cowan Spectrum.

Then and Now: Memorial Gym



In 1956, basketball practice ran about three hours Monday through Saturday, and put player Weldon Wood '60, a Phi Gamma Delta, back at the Fiji house around 7:30 p.m.

At the end of the day, there was a dried-out dinner waiting for him in the oven. Then it was on to studying and eventually falling asleep at his desk. The next day: Back to Memorial Gym for more.

Idaho Football Legend Inspires





University of Idaho legend, Sandpoint native and Lombardi-era Green Bay Packer star Jerry Kramer played football for the Vandals in the 1950s, prior to heading to the big leagues.

The 1958 alumnus is known for many things during his 11-year career in the NFL: his Packers won two Super Bowls, five NFL championships and he was a perennial All-Pro selection. In addition to being named to the 50th anniversary team, Kramer was selected for the NFL 1960s All-Decade team.







Surprises in the SUB



There are a few orange construction cones still up, but the renovation of the Student Union Building's second-floor foyer, study area and brand new Vandal Ballroom is nearing a close. Construction on the 15,000-square-foot space started last fall, and is scheduled for completion within the next 30 days. A team of about 40-50 local craftsmen had a hand in the project, including TML Construction of Hayden, idaho, and Castellaw Korn Architects of Lewiston (owned by two Vandals).

The lobby boasts new carpet and a new speaker and lighting system throughout. New furnishings and a massive tech upgrade will make it easier for students to stay plugged in and comfortable while they study.

The new 4,400 square-foot Vandal Ballroom was constructed in the previous locations of the Silver and Chiefs meeting rooms to provide a mid-sized event space on campus, it can seat around 250 guests while the international Ballroom across the way seats 450. Dividing panels will allow the room to be split into three spaces.

A small meeting room off the study area has been renamed the Chiefs Room, and there are new men's and women's restrooms on the same floor.




This will be the third NCAA Tournament trip for the Vandal women. Idaho first made the tournament in 1984, after a 28-2 season.


Today, that fireplace is another piece of Targhee's history. The facility hasn't had an indoor fireplace since the 1980s.

UI hosts indoor championships for first time in history



Did you know?

- The women's 4x400m relay team broke a 12-year school record in the 2013 Western Athletic Conference Indoor Track & Field Championships. The Vandals finished the meet with 10 First-Team All-WAC honors and 10-Second Team All-WAC honors.
- Two-time Olympian Angela Whyte '03 scored more points in the Big West track and field conference championships than the entire Boise State team.
- Current Assistant Coach Albx Potratz-Lee '10 was the first and only woman in WAC history to win
 the 3000m steeplechase, the 5000 m, and the 10,000m at the WAC Outdoor championship meet.
 Winning these three events in one meet has only been done three times in NCAA history. She is
 also the only woman in WAC history to be named WAC Athlete of the Year in three different
 sports.
- When former Vandal thrower and current UI Track and Field Coach Julie Taylor graduated from Idaho in 1986, she held both Idaho outdoor school records in the shot put and discus. Since that time, her athletes have broken and re-broken every Idaho throws record. Taylor saw her name officially bumped out of the Idaho record book in 2011, but she still holds an incredible distinction in

idaho's history. She coached every single athlete who has made an entry in idaho's all-time top 10 in the women's shot put, discus, hammer throw and javelin throw.

For the first time in idaho history, the men's and women's track and field teams hosted the Western Athletic Conference indoor Track & Field Championship Feb. 26-28.

The University of Idaho men's track and field team claimed the 2014 championship title in a dramatic meet that came down to one point. The women ended the meet in third place with 127 points, Missouri-Kansas City took the second place spot with 144.5 and Grand Canyon finished the meet as WAC Champions with 166.5 points.



Waves on an Allen World

UI physics researchers find first evidence of waves in Titan's methane seas

Someday, researchers hope to land a spacecraft on Titan, Saturn's largest moon. When they do, they need to know what, exactly, they're landing in.

"We want our spacecraft to splash, not splat," says Jason Barnes, an associate professor of physics at the University of Idaho.

He and his students work with researchers around the nation studying Titan through NASA's Cassini spacecraft. Barnes has been working with Cassini since the craft arrived in the Saturn system in 2004.

The Idaho men's and women's tennis teams each <u>captured Western Athletic Conference championships</u> Sunday as the top-seeded women beat No. 3 New Mexico State 4-1 and the second-seeded Vandal men beat NM State 4-3. It's the first WAC championship for both programs.

Both teams will take on the University of Southern California Trojans in the first round of the NCAA tournament. Junior Lelianie Kim shot an even-par 72 during the final day of the tournament to win the individual title with a 54-hole total 224. Cassle McKinley earned first-team all-conference honors with her tie for third at 229.

<u>Track and field</u> competed in the Cougar invitational Saturday with 10 individual wins and two Vandals reigning double champions over the meet.

Senior Karlene Hurrel was first across the finish line in the 100m with a wind-aided time of 12.23; she also placed first in the 200m with a wind-aided time of 24.65. Junior Ben Ayesu-Attah also earned a double over the day, finishing first in the 400m with a time of 47.89 and tied for the first-place spot in the 200m with a wind-aided time of 21.50.





Dig Starts at One of Boise's Oldest Buildings



University of Idaho professor and archaeologist Mark Warner is leading a team of students and community volunteers in an excavation near one of the oldest buildings in Boise this week. The "surgeon's quarters" building was one of the first buildings constructed as part of Fort Boise.

Originally called "Camp Boise", the fort was founded on July 4, 1863, to protect emigrants and miners who were traveling through the area on their way to Oregon. Building 4, which is the focus of Warner's excavation, was constructed during the initial site development that occurred in the first year after the camp was founded.





The Sticky Secrets of Geckos



About 1,400 species of geckos roam the Earth. Their lineage dates back 200 million years, making them the oldest group of living lizards. They're even older than the dinosaurs.

But scientists have only recently begun to understand their remarkable abilities to stick to - and easily release from - surfaces such as rocks, trees and ceilings.

University of Idaho gecko-feet expert Travis Hagey's most recent research — funded by the National Science Foundation's BEACON Center for Evolution in Action — focuses on building the most finely detailed models of gecko toe pads ever created.

The Remnants of Life

The excavation of Ft. Boise's historic "Surgeon's Quarters"



Christmas, 1953. A Ft. Boise Army doctor and his family gather around their dining table and stop to take a snapshot. A click and a flash, and like a visual time capsule the moment is preserved.

Six decades later, the photograph still hangs on the dining room wall of the "Surgeon's Quarters" as a reminder — to University of Idaho archaeologists and local volunteers — of the people who inhabited the 150-year-old home and left behind remnants of their lives.

Excavating the front porch area of the building, UI anthropology professor Mark Warner leads a team in search of these remnants, which include and a 1902 milk-bottle cap, a ceramic marble and a child's saucer from a tea set.

Have We Contaminated Mars?



When the Curiosity Mars rover arrived on the rocky planet, it may have had bacterial stowaways, says Stephanie Smith, a microbiologist at the University of Idaho. That may mean that if we do missions to detect life on Mars, we may find bacteria that

evolved on Earth.

Her group used swabs from Curiosity's surface before it was launched, finding over 60 species. The group cultivated 377 strains of bacteria, and tested them in extreme conditions: drying them out, dropping the temperature, bombarding them with UV radiation and extremely alkaline environments. Almost 11 percent of bacteria survived at least one of these conditions.

The Science of Fire



In 2012, 80 percent of the 9.3 million acres burned by wildfire in the United States were in the 11 western states. Idaho, Oregon and Montana saw the most activity with 44 percent of the total burned acres.

This year, a wildfire emergency has been declared with flames consuming nearly 400 square miles in north-central Washington state. Whiskey Complex fires near Boise, Idaho, have burned 8,500 acres since Saturday.

The University of Idaho is the leading university in wildfire research, education and collaboration. With the first certified wildfire ecology program in the nation and the only university lab dedicated to the study of combustion and smoke emissions, UI is internationally renowned for its fire science.



UI Knows How to Go Green





University of Idaho was named one of the top six places to find green rooftops by Just Energyi Our green roof atop the UI Student Union Building was implemented in 2008 and covers 1,650 square feet — the largest in Moscow.

Besides helping regulate temperature within the SUB, the green roof is self-sustaining with its own drainage system to collect rain runoff and move it through its irrigation system.

Many varieties of sedum are planted on the roof. Sedum are flowering plants with varieties capable of living in mountainous tundra-type locations as well as tropical ones. Mark Miller, associate director of operation for the Idaho Commons and SUB, said the plants are best suited for the harsh environment of a green roof.

"The roof has matured to the point where it's closer to the ultimate goal of an extensive green roof — to get to the point where you have the types of plants you don't have to provide irrigation for," he said.
