From rock concerts to marching band competitions, the Kibbie/ASUI Activity Center provides music to please a wide audience.

The combination of a large arena floor and permanent and portable turf seating give the Dome the flexibility to satisfy any performer.

To ensure adequate volume, the building is equipped with 14 200-watt amplifiers. The sound system also includes ten speakers that are time-delayed for maximum efficiency. There is sufficient power to the floor for visiting sound systems. The acoustical tile "clouds" suspended from the ceiling and the sound-absorbing end walls guarantee high quality.



Because of the large floor area, the Kibbie/ASUI Activity Center can accomodate large scale events. The possibilities number as far as the mind can reach.

Cowboys and cowgirls take center stage every spring with the Idaho Western Classic Rodeo. The Wild West is moved inside as tractors create the dirt arena needed to punch them doggies and buck those broncos.

The tents stay packed when the circus visits the Palouse. Under the Dome's Big Top, clowns and tigers, elephants and acrobats entertain adults and children alike.




and appliances.

## athletics

The Kibbie/ASUI Activity Center is a sports facility for all seasons. Autumn Saturdays on the Palouse belong to Vandal football. 17,000 faithful supporters often give the boost needed to bring home a victory. When the game is over.

the Tartan rug can be rolled up to reveal the versatile all-purpose Tartan flooring beneath.

As temperatures drop in winter, the action heats up on the basketball courts. The Idaho mens and women's basketball squads entertain as many as 8,000 enthusiastic fans. The non-varsity athlete can run the fast break on any of nine other courts housed in "the Dome".

Curtains 20' high by 196' long can be lowered onto the field. This allows a number of activities to be enjoyed from winter into spring.

The fair-weather jogger can take advantage of the controlled climate, running laps around the 300 meter track. Floor sections can be removed uncovering two sand pits for long and triple jump and two pole vault boxes. These allow the Vandal track team to practice as well as host complete indoor meets.



Tennis enthusiasts can get their point across on the eight courts available.

The east end Varsity Center, completed in 1982, houses locker rooms, showers, and ticket and athletic department offices. In addition, there is a fully-equipped weight room and eight racquetball courts, one with a clear back wall for exhibition games.

No matter what the time of year, the sports lover will have a ball at the Dome.



## size and structure

The Kibbie/ASUI Activity Center is an acclaimed architectural accomplishment, named in national competition as the Outstanding Structural Engineering Achievement of 1976 by the American Society of Civil Engineers. The Dome is, in fact, a large barrel vault with roof arches clearing a span of 400 feet. The building is 410' wide by 498' long with the floor-to-ceiling dimension of 150 feet equivalent to a 14-story building. The floor area covers 93,500 square feet, while the roof above it covers nearly four and a half acres.

## services

Services and features of the Kibbie/ASUI Activity Center make it a very adaptable facility.

There are concessions stands on both the north and south concourses, and a mobile concessions trailer is available for use on the arena



floor. Restrooms and drinking fountains are conveniently placed throughout the Dome and Varsity Center. Two 12'x16' roll-up doors are at floor level on the east end, providing easy access for vehicles.

The pressbox space includes the first floor writing area, private booths for radio coverage and announcers on the second floor, and the third level photo deck.

The building is equipped with a number of safety features. Each concourse has a fully-equipped first aid room. A fire alarm system is in constant operation and fire sprinkler systems are installed. In case of power failure, automatic lighting exists on the stairs and concourses for emergency exit.
