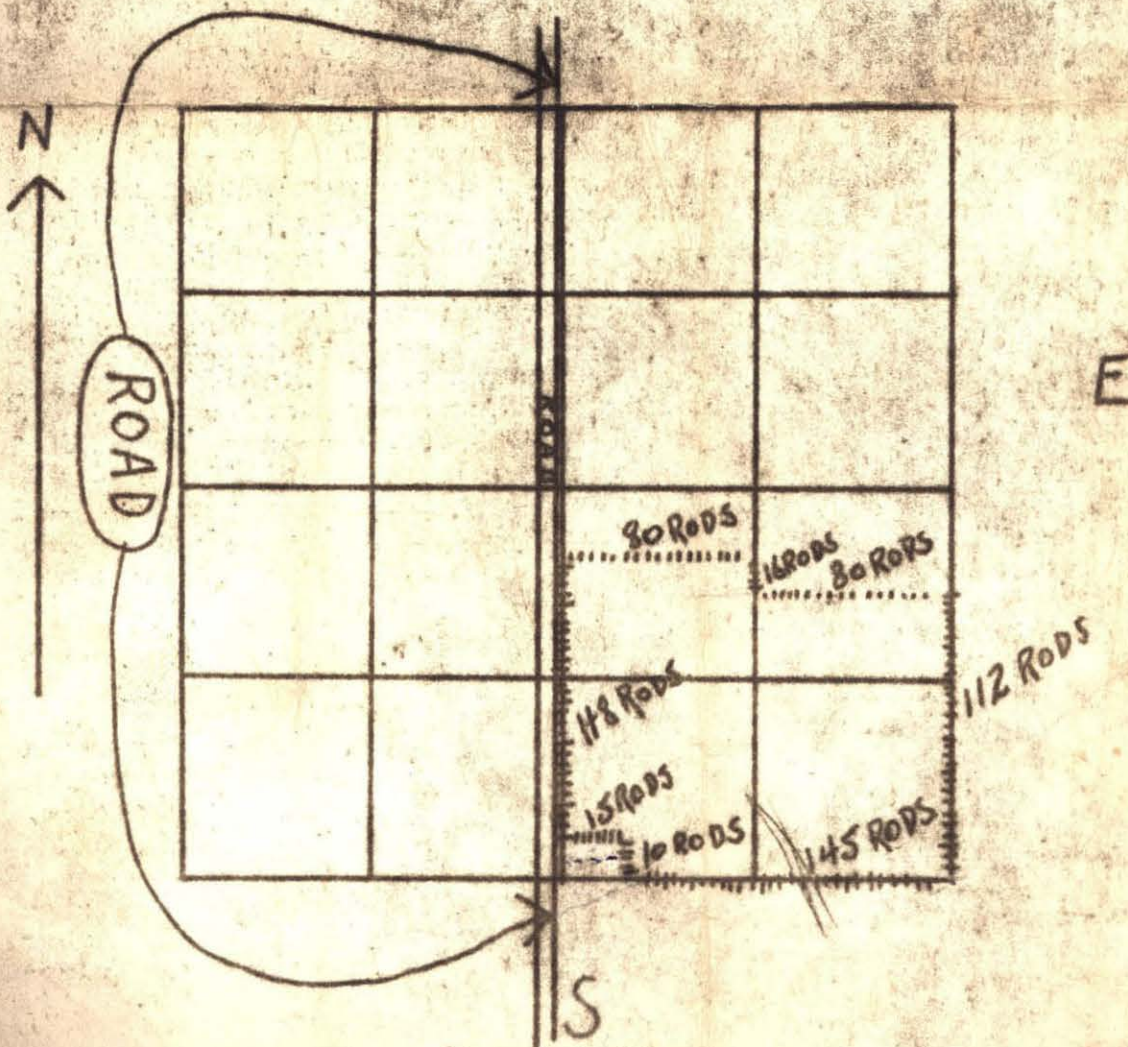

Beginning at the SW corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 3, Township 38, Range 5 WBM, thence running east 15 rods thence at right angles north 5 rods, thence at right angles west 15 rods, thence running south 5 rods to the place of beginning, containing one half acre more or less, save and except the public road.

I realize that this is very detailed and complex but that some decision needs to be arrived at, whether a corrected deed could or should be furnished. If so, please indicate the correct procedure to be followed.

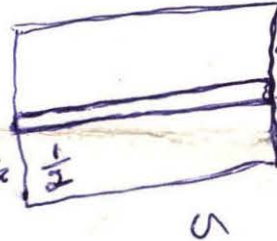

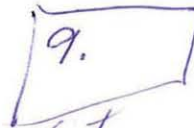
