August 16. th 1864

Dear Parents, I take My pen in hand to informe you that I am not well enough to go to My Regiment yet I am do to be about I dont know when I shall go, I hope this few lines will find you all well. I am some weak yet I may stay till after pay day the first of September, I expect that there is letters on the road some where it takes them a good while to go to the Regiment & then back to me. So you ma, & Pa write to Me as soon as you get this if I shood feel it will come to me.

I have some Diarrhea now but not very bad there is a good money die here with the diarrhea, write as soon as you get this, I sent home 25. dollars in a letter write how you are giting along and all of the news you can, there

Not much news here to write
here now, the wether is ~~pretty~~ pretty
hot here now.

I dont now the leason will go this
fall. lincon & belandingham of new
york ~~are~~ are going to run for president
I hope they will git in a democrat
president this time but they are
going to try to elect lincon
agin but I dont beleve they make
it out. Father write to me and
let me no who ~~they~~ the you are
going to vote fore for our president
if they dont git up a good Man
I shant vot, I hope this war will
be over this fall they will ^{be} some thing
done I think. well I dont feel very
well so I will quit for this time
the docter will be around now
in a few minets. So good by to y all
fore this time. write soon
