South Carolina, January 28/1865

Dear Parents, I take my pen in hand to write a few lines to you to let you know that I am well & I hope these few lines will find you all well. We have left Savannah & are making our way towards Charleston the Regiment started to march it by land we went to two days & then we had orders to go back to Savannah & go by water Round on the Sea Coast to a place name Beauford a nice little town about 60 Miles from Savannah up the Coast we are camped about 6 Miles out in the Country from Beauford & we are about are about 50 Miles from Charleston there is some talk of a Settle Mont but Sherman will make them come to some terms or another. I got the paper all right & inclosed. So good by.
