



Nashville April the 17th 1864

Dear Parents,

I take my pen in hand to inform you all that I am well at present & I hope these few lines will find you the same, I received your letter yesterday & was very glad to hear from you for I heard that Father was sick. I got a letter from Ann today the 20. of March she wrote that y^r s^r was to home & heard that you was sick. So I was anxious to get a letter. I am quite smart now & am going to try Camp life again I dont now how long I will stant but I must go to morrow to the regiment they are about 40. miles from here I will haft to go to the barrack first & stay untill I can get transportation. I may not haft to stay more then one day.
