Purchaser to pay all freight charges in cash on arrival of car, same to be deducted from invoice at time of settlement. Our title not to pass until freight is paid.

Freight net cash. Original Expense Bill to be presented for credit.

Remittances to be made free of charge. Exchange will be charged to your account. Accounts are subject to sight draft, with cost of collection, if not paid at maturity.

In making delivered prices, cost of goods delivered at destination is guaranteed, but not against delay in transit or causes beyond our control.

Claims will not be allowed unless made within 5 days after receipt of goods. The lumber shipped is sold on standard grade of the Mississippi Valley Lumbermen's Association, and in case of dispute over quality of lumber, the above inspection to govern as basis of settlement.

In case of transfer of business, insolvency or suit begun by any other creditor, bill becomes immediately due.
