It holds all things together, it creates, and it sustains all life—INCLUDING YOURS. This, then, brings God to you as a living entity. It places all the Power of God at your disposal. So why bother someone else with your spiritual problems when there, wherever you are, lies the great Fountain-Head of all wisdom and power— God. God is life. God is love. God is light. And the Spirit of God gives you all of these things in the very moment you recognize this great Presence. The quiet "talking with God" will take on new Power as you progress in these Studies.
