



LETTER OF TRANSMISSION WITH LESSON 36



DEAR FELLOW-STUDENT:

Here, beloved, is your Lesson No. 36. In it we continue our researches into the claims of many of the "crucified gods" of antiquity. Some ministers ask me why I deal with these things at all. It is absolutely necessary that the proper setting of present-day theology be given to the world. If that is not done, there will be many who need the true Light, but who won't be able to see it because their "spiritual adviser" will tell them that these "gods" did not exist. But my Students are intelligent people. All Americans are intelligent. Moreover, they are honest. They want to know the TRUTH about God. And I shall tell them that Truth. When the true setting of our present religious structure is known, then the TRUE picture of God is absorbed so much easier. That's why I am publishing these truths. I am not interested in "tearing down" anything—if it be true. But I cannot be true to my God, true to you, or true to myself if I do not pass on to you the information I have gathered over many years. Error will never fade out truth. It may cast a shadow over it for a time, but truth will finally conquer. Of course, those who have been preaching error will be hurt as the truth is made manifest. But it's better that a few be hurt than that many be blindfolded to the truth. So we shall continue. If God had not been behind me, I should have passed into oblivion long ago, as certainly very few men would have come through the persecution I came through. Think about me every day. I feel so helpless in this big work—yet—through the Power of God—I feel so strong.
