Operating as heavily by mail as we do, it is absolutely necessary that the burden be borne by Members of this organization. Otherwise, we could not operate and grow as we have grown. Nevertheless I want as manly as possible to receive our Teaching because I know that in that way, the Power of God can be rapidly spread through the earth.

If you know of a family who you believe to be interested in these Truths, and who is really unable to pay for our Lessons, won't you write me a confidential letter giving me the facts? I'd like very much to help that family by sending our Lessons to them without cost. Now you will understand that you will have to use good judgment.
