I have writen you several times on the same subject that I am writing you now, and I sincerely hope you not mind my writing again. When we started to make plans for this trip to Europe and adopt these children there were so many things that no one knew about one said see this one he said see another the upshot of it all is that no one seemed to know the answeres, so I wrote you asking for help to get the passports and the Visa and want to say we are very happy that we did receive them, now as far as the adoption is that is all taken care of and will go through as soon as we arrive there (we are leaving New York Aug. 20th flying) but now they write and say the returning of the children with us is a question and we want to return them with us. one says you can or they woulden't have given you a permit at the State Dept. another says the laws have changed so now we are going and I have asked and trusted God with every thing up to date and it has turned out beautiful so we are going and know that God will take care of us in return with the children on Sept. 25. and can I please ask you again to give us some help I don't like to keep asking for this every couple weeks but this means so much to us this returning with them that I am in great hopes you will not mind. So let me repeat that we will return with them and that we will keep well and have no trouble with the return of our selves and our children on Sept. 25. It is just wonderful to sit back and see how things have gone along here things seemed so uncertain but I went ahead any way several said you are pretty sure you are going aren'tland said I shoulden't be to dissapointed but I just told them I knew that I was going and had no intention of being dissappointed, and I feel the same about returning with the children it isen't that any one says it impossible but every one says to see some one else and the immigration office, American Consul and the State Dept. are all involved in this and they are saying get permission from this or that one and when I see them they say we aren't able to so that is how it stands. So as I said we are going and know that every thing is going to be alright and give us your help which I appreciate so much and thank you.
