My Dear Dr. Robinson:-

I am one of your students and have just finished your 10th. lesson.


I find your lessons wonderful and very inspiring but I have not dared to allow myself to even think that a transformation could come in my

Dear Sir:-

The persecution of Dr. Frank B. Robinson of Moscow, Idaho,- (the originator of Pyschiana) has come to my notice. The investigation, as I understand it, is an attempt on the part of someone to make out that Fyshiana's teaching is a mail fraud. Such statement will never be given out by me, for I know better! This teaching is worth many times more to me than the tiny little sum that I paid for it; and to date I have taken only the first course of lessons. Further,- I hope to read everything that Dr. Frank B. Robinson has ever given to the world; for, in my estimation he has written more truth to date concerning the absolute existence of the Spirit of the Living God than I had ever discovered in the Bible. ~~But~~, ~~Now~~ the Bible just opens up so clear and plain,- and I understand things now that I never undertook to understand before. For instance, I find that God ^{is} referred to as Spirit at lease eighty two times, and perhaps many times more if I looked it up. The subject is so great and so vast it cannot even be touched. If you were to ask me if the "God-Law" that Dr. Robinson teaches about actually works for me, my answer is "YES, AND FOREVER!" This means that the end is not yet. Might I suggest, Mr. Morse, if you have not done so, to please procure the complete course of Pyschiana lessons. You will be told how the Spirit of the Living God guides you, guards you, upholds you and defends you every instant of your life, and at that, when you are lease ~~aware~~ aware. As I write this, I have lessor No.10 of the Advanced Course number one here on the table. Not that this lesson excells any of the others, but it is one of the most marvelous things that was ever put in print.

This letter is long, but in order that you may know, I must relate facts. Court records cannot lie. In the first place, I own the south west 1/4 of section 17, in township 48, range 10, west of 2nd. meridian. Mr. Pettis has the east half in this same section 17, being his homestead and soldier grant. Generally speaking we have always referred to the place that I own ^{as} "the Wilson place"; for a man named William Wilson homesteaded that quarter. Though I have had this place quite a while, it is just called "the Wilson place." Mr. Wilson is dead. This farm is black loam soil,- and it has been coveted by several persons including the Cummings family, their kith, ken, inlaw and etc. A Mr. Hackett, who married one of the breed-Indian Cummings girls, has acted as an unauthorized agent to dispose of that farm. This has been going on for several years. Mr. Jas. Storey, the Sec.-Treas. of this

Rural Municipality of Arborfield, married a sister to Mr. Hackett's wife, - a Cummings girl. In my estimation this Municipality is ridden by that Cummings family, their in-laws and disciples. One after another of their offers was turned down by me. (I loved my place, and I like to walk about over there). - - But, - at last, they found one, Mr. William Miller (a relative of theirs of course) in whom Mr. Pettis had absolute confidence in! Mr. Miller would barter a few things if possible, in order to get that land. He offered me an old radio. I didn't let him bring it in the house. He then offered me a set of harness. I told him we has no horses, moreover when I worked I did not wear harness; - I left the room with no more interview. But Mr. Miller was determined to have that quarter section of land, and Mr. Pettis was determined that he should! Over my protest events moved swiftly. This, Mr. Morse has been a year ago. On June 2nd., I think it was, I wrote Mr. Miller the following: "We have decided not to dispose of my southwest quarter of Sec. 17, for we have been able to pay all taxes that have ever been paid since the close of the World War." On going to mail that letter I had to cross my place. In going over I found what appeared to be a camp outfit, - on returning I met Mr. Miller at work right there. I told him the content of the letter I had just mailed, and said further "to give this place up, would be like the death of a very dear friend of mine, for I loved it." The controversy between me and Mr. Pettis might take several pages to write, which you likely would not care to read; other than to say that everything went negative for me. My place I regard worth at least \$5000. sold for \$1200. Not one cent as cash down payment. Nothing bartered in exchange. Payments might go on until 1947 if need be. It would also take a page or two to write of the scene right here in the house. Jim Story and his wife and Mr. Miller and his wife had arrived in Story's car. Mr. Story had made out the contract for the sale of the land. Oh, how I remember that hour! I was not allowed to talk. I was hedged in on all sides! I was told "Not to go batty over such a silly little thing" by Jim Story's wife, when I could not keep down cry any longer. My hand was shaky as I ^{was} compelled to sign the sale contract. They sped away in Mr. Story's new car that just radiates light. - - - Not many days hence, - and the very trees that I was so used to (not that I worship a one of them - not that) began to be removed, and burn piles for clearing began to show up! The old trail where I used to walk and the grove of bright green trees was all forbidden ground now to me. The place that was so familiar to me was rapidly changing, and at that right in seeing distance of me. Each day brought more. I cannot express what spiritual reaction took possession of me. I cannot explain it, for it cannot be done. But Dr. Robinson tells us that there is such a thing as Quiet Power. I was sneered at by certain of the neighbors for having sold a 160 acres - and not a cent down. (In reality I never sold it). Weeks were going by, - and I could see the place I loved so well being torn up. But, the Miller's etc. were wild with joy. Once as I was going along the public road I had to pass by not far from where they were at work, - that is - I was in hearing distance. They shouted this

"HI HO! Biddle! The cat and the fiddle! The cow danced over the moon! But, the little dog laughed to see the sport of the dish run away with the spoon! HYEEEE! HYOOOO! WHOOP! YELL! YEEEEEER!" I could not but see they were waving their arms in the air. A dog was barking ready to run at me if necessary at their bidding. Much as I felt that the situation - first to last - physically was killing me. It looked as if situation was 100 % negative to me. There was no one but my Creator to tell it to. And, out of that Quiet Stillness there came Power. And with that, came an assurance that that insulting "gang" was, so to speak, under my feet.

- - - - I will ^{continue} the discussion from here to the end later. But, I believe in the Power of the Living God. Surely, Mr. Morse you are familiar with the Bible: but let me call your attention ^{to what} I find therein. Jeremiah 9:24 "Let him that glorieth glory in this: that he understandeth and knoweth Me, that I am the Lord which exercise loving kindness, judgment and righteousness in the earth: for, in these things I delight, saith the Lord." Again, - Jeremiah 23: verses 23, 24 & 25 - "I am a God at hand, saith the Lord, and not a God afar off. Can any hide himself in a secret place that I shall not see him? Saith the Lord. Do not I fill heaven and earth? saith the Lord". Where does this put God? David recognized it, saying, (Ps. 139:7) "Where shall I go from Thy Spirit? Or where shall I go from Thy presence?" One of the greatest things that Jesus said was, "Be ye reconciled to God." During his conversation with the woman of Samaria, he said, "The hour cometh and now is when the true worshipers shall worship the Father in Spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship. God is Spirit, and they that worship Him must worship Him in Spirit and truth." You are no doubt familiar with his remark to certain of those around him from the fact - "That ye do always resist the Spirit of God." He tells us of the source of his miraculous power, - "If I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you." Dr. Frank B. Robinson tells us too, that he has seen lives transformed by it: "And God wrought special miracles by the hands of Paul," Acts 19-21. Further, Paul recognized the source of the power he used: - Romans 15-19 "Through mighty signs and wonders by the Power of the Spirit of God." In Job 32 - 8, we have this statement: "There is a spirit in man: and the inspiration of the Almighty giveth them instruction." Jesus tells us "The kingdom of God is within you." Notice what Jesus said when Lazarus was made alive again: - "Did I not say unto thee, if thou wouldst believe thou should see the glory of God." He tells us too, "These things shall ye do and greater also." He emphasised the point several times "Of myself I can do nothing." Maybe there are folks who do not believe in the Omnipresent Living God, just because God is invisible. In 1st. Corinthians 2 - 14 we have this statement: - "But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them for they are spiritually discerned." Jesus speaking on this said, (St. Jno. 14, 16-17) "I will pray unto the Father and He give you another comforter - that He may abide with you forever, - even the Spirit of Truth: Whom the world cannot receive because it seeth Him not neither knoweth Him, for He dwelleth in you and shall be in you." Mr. Morse, - where does this put the Spirit of the Living God? A person had as well put a finger on a push-button

and try to stop this great moving universe, as to try to stop Psychiana and what it teaches, for that cannot be done. And, I am under the honest impression that those organizations called "churches" will disolve and at last accept the only thing that Jesus came to tell about,- and he used the Power of God to the full.

- - - - I am a U. S. American. Born near Durhan, Misseouri, went to common school, later to Kirksville State normal. Later took a business course,- accepted a position as railroad station agent and telegraph operator at my home town. I merely mention this to substantiate the claim that I am not an imbecile. I united with the Baptist church, and never did I once hear that the ever present Living God was accessible here and now. I cant help but think there must be a swindle for those who pay tribute to escape this-that-and-the other, as I know certain of my acquaintences do: when Jesus warned them beforehand "Render unto Caesar the things which are Caesar's but unto God the things which are God's."

- - - - As I said before,- I had no one to take into my confidence but my Creator. Unreasonable absolute falsehoods:- and statements that I had never made were going their rounds of this neighborhood: things that there was no truth in whatsoever. The description of me is unprintable and unmailable. Before now, I had heard the expression, "struck the bottom",-that is the way I felt. And I questioned "There is God that He may be found?" I think I know how Job of old felt when he said,"Even today is my complaint bitter: my stroke is heavier than my groaning. Oh that I knew where I might find Him! That I might come even to His seat! I would order my cause before Him, and fill my mouth with arguments. I would know the words which He would answer me. Will He plead against me with His great Power? No; He will put strength in me. There the righteous might dispute with Him, so I should be delivered forever from my judge." Mr. Morse, this old patriarch knew full well that he was dealing with an invisible God. To continue,- "Behold I go forward, but He is not there, and backward and I cannot preceive Him:: On the left hand where He deeth work, but I cannot behold Him: He hideth Himself on the right hand that I cannot see Him: But He knoweth the way that I take, when He hath tried me, I shall come forth as gold." Job also knew there is ~~such~~ ^{which} science calls the Cosmic (life) Ray. His description is this:- Job 28, 7-8 "There is a path which no fowel knoweth, and which the vulture's eye hath not seen; the lion's whelps have not trodden it, nor the fierce lion passed by it." 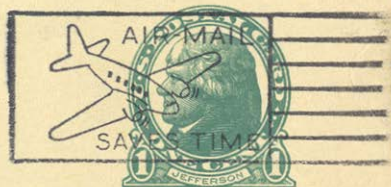



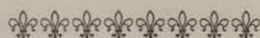

VERY IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL STUDENTS



I have in my possession a form letter being sent out to my Students by Postal Inspector Morse of Seattle. This form letter asks if my Student dealings have been satisfactory in every way, and asks them to notify the Postal Inspector, giving details, if they have not been satisfactory, etc. If I were asked to hazard a guess as to the reason for this letter going out, I should say that Mr. Morse was trying to find some dissatisfied Student who is willing to swear to a complaint which can be used as a basis for a mail-fraud charge.

Inspector Morse made a personal investigation of "PSYCHIANA" about two years ago, and he knows as well as I know that there is not the slightest taint of fraud connected with this Movement. If there had been, the two Postal investigations prior to this latest one certainly would have uncovered it. My Students know what's going on, and so do I know what's going on. I think what I have been made to go through during the past three years is perhaps the most vicious, foul, un-American persecution ever to be directed against any religious leader in 400 years. If you knew the inside of it as I know it, your blood would boil I assure you.

However--knowing that there is no fraud connected with this Movement, I am asking my Students to cooperate with Inspector Morse to the best of their ability. If there should be a Student anywhere (which I very much doubt) who thinks he has just cause to believe he or she has been defrauded out of money through the mail, I am asking such Student to write Inspector Morse stating fully and completely just how and when he considers he was defrauded through the mails. All I ask is that in a spirit of American fairness to me, he send me also a copy of the letter of complaint. To the rest of my Students who will or have received this form letter of the Post Office department, if you feel that your dealings with me have been satisfactory, write Inspector Morse a nice letter and tell him so. Then send to me a copy of your letter to him, together with the form letter he sent you.

I have told you before, and I repeat it now---NO STONE WILL BE LEFT UNTURNED IN AN EFFORT TO STOP THIS TEACHING. Not because it's false but because it's true, and if it is not stopped, the churches know that their future is very insecure when the TRUE LIGHT of GOD, as I reveal it, is made known to all. I tread on their toes--there's no question about that, but if these religious organizations are not teaching the truth about God, their toes should be trodden on. Truth is truth, and no efforts to stop it will ever be successful. As my Assistant Dr. Tenney says:--"GOD HELP THE CHURCHES IF THEIR FUTURE EXISTENCE DEPENDS UPON THE CRUSHING OF "PSYCHIANA."

If you are satisfied that you have not been defrauded, tell Mr. Morse that also, but send me his form letter with a copy of your reply.

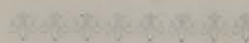
