Dear Mr. Greene:-

In order to bring to an end the cowardly, subversive, un-American attacks your "bureaus" have been making on The Psychiana Religion, I am here and now, openly and through the mail, charging your organization with being what I have so many times before charged, A SUBVERSIVE UN-AMERICAN ORGANIZATION IN THAT FOR YEARS IT HAS ATTEMPTED TO SUPPRESS RELIGION IN THE UNITED STATES. THE PSYCHIANA RELIGION TO BE EXACT.

Now there isn't any question about what I mean, is there Mr. Greene. If the Psychiana Religion is as dishonest as you have claimed it to be, and if its advertising is as fraudulent as you have indicated to various newspapers and magazines, then the proper place to make your charges is in Federal Court, is it not Mr. Greene? I have hoped against hope that you would do that. Evidently you do not intend to. So then, in order to make it easier for you to prefer your charges against Psychiana in the Federal Courts, where the truth will be obtained, I am giving wide distribution to this circular, hoping that it will have the effect of forcing your hand.

If this happens Mr. Greene, it would mean that all the scientific literature your various branches throughout the United States have used to try to suppress this religion, would have to be brought into Federal Court. This literature would then become part of the record, and the business men who have been supporting your organization would then have an opportunity to know just to what extent your un-American attempts to suppress this religion of ours have been carried. There is nothing I would like better than that Mr. Greene.

But you won't do that--will you Mr. Greene. You are afraid to. Besides, your attorneys won't let you, will they Mr. Greene. For instance, if you did that, the nice letter you sent to me years ago when you were soliciting my membership would have to be produced, wouldn't it Mr. Greene.

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Then too, there ~~is~~ a lot of other letters and bulletins your various branches have sent to newspaper and magazine publishers in your vile, subversive attempts to suppress The Psychiana Religion. For instance Mr. Greene, there is the correspondence which passed between your H.I. McEldowney and Mr. Will Moore, the publisher of The Detroit News. That would be very interesting reading, wouldn't it Mr. Greene.

Then too, the correspondence which passed between Mr. James W. Brown of THE EDITOR AND PUBLISHER, and Mr. George D. Crain Jr. of ADVERTISING AGE. All of this literature would have to be produced, wouldn't it Mr. Greene. And letters you and your stooges have sent to various newspapers and magazines, and statements they have made over the radio--all these would have to be introduced in evidence, wouldn't they Mr. Greene.

And there is some correspondence from your Tacoma office isn't there Mr. Greene? For instance, a well-known author and Professor of Religion in one of our largest universities was recently addressing the Kiwanis Club in Tacoma, wasn't he Mr. Greene. And after the address, your "manager" Mr. Bob West took this gentleman to his office and tried to tell him what a racket the Psychiana Movement is--didn't he Mr. Greene. And then there was some correspondence wasn't there Mr. Greene. Mighty interesting correspondence. The letter this nationally-known theologian wrote to Mr. West--that would have to be introduced in evidence, wouldn't it Mr. Greene.

Then again, all the correspondence which passed between Lyle Janz of your Portland office--that too would have to be introduced--unless of course you decide to destroy all this correspondence beforehand. But I'll take a chance on that Mr. Greene--you see--I have copies of some very nice letters written by your "bureaus" to newspapers and magazines. I have many of your "bulletins" in my possession, and the mute but irrefutable evidence is that you and your entire organization have for years been trying to suppress my religion by trying to make it impossible for us to advertise in newspapers, as other religions do. Isn't that it Mr. Greene?

And the letters McEldowney wrote to the Post-office inspectors some years ago. Were they not intended to stop Psychiana from using the mails? And the correspondence with the Ohio Securities Commissioner, and the S.E.C. Was not the intent of that literature to haul the founder of Psychiana into court and stop his religion? If not--for what purpose were these letters written Mr. Greene? Please tell us. Many business men would like to know why, after all these letters of yours had been written to the Post-office and the S.E.C. we still use the mails to the tune of \$100,000 last years, and included in the literature we send through the mails is the circular which you claimed was "offering unsecured notes to the general public". Why is it Mr. Greene that neither you nor any of your many branches have been able to interest any government agency into doing more than investigate?

If all the fraud and dishonesty you have widely proclaimed has really been going on--if we are so bad that our advertising should not be allowed to appear in newspapers and magazines, is not our Federal Government being very lax Mr. Greene? We have operated exclusively by mail for about twenty years, and neither you nor anyone else has been able to give to any government agency the slightest scintilla of evidence that there is either dishonesty or fraud connected with us. Why is

this Mr. Greene?

If we are operating lawfully, and if we are terribly in earnest in our efforts to reveal the Power of The Spirit of God to humanity, why do you pick on us? Why not the Roman Catholic Church, or the Presbyterian Church, or the Methodist Church. If you take this matter into court Mr. Greene, which you wont, you would have to answer all of these questions and you couldn't do that---could you Mr. Greene.

In October 1946 Mr. Greene, I was invited to speak on the campuses of several large universities. As the true significance of Psychiana begins to dawn on theologians and educators, there are more and more demands for personal addresses from me. Then too, Mr. Greene, there were addresses before Rotary and Kiwanis---remember? And you found out about those university addresses--didn't you Mr. Greene. And you wrote to the Presidents of those colleges. And you demanded a transcript of everything I said there. And you personally signed the letter Mr. Greene--didn't you? And of course, you have in your files the answers you received from the Presidents of these universities, haven't you Mr. Greene. Well I am sure that those who support your organization by buying "memberships" and making "donations" to you should see those replies--dont you Mr. Greene.

And then again, there are so many other letters in your files which I know about, and all of these, if you are honest, should also be brought into Federal Court Mr. Greene, shouldn't they? Then too, you have been very insistent that Psychiana, a tax-exempt religious organization file a statement with you, which, of course, we just couldn't see our way to do. At least, we could not until the rest of the major systems of religion have done that, and somehow or other we can hardly believe that the Roman Catholic, The Methodist, The Presbyterian Churches have filed statements with you. But if you go into Federal Court Mr. Greene, you would have to file, along with all your branches, financial statements of your own. Your Detroit "bureau" for instance would have to show the Federal Court just how much of the money received from "memberships" was spent trying to destroy my religion. And that wouldn't look very good--would it Mr. Greene.

And Father Flanagan too. The attacks of the Buffalo "bureau" on his activities, they would have to come out into the open also, wouldn't they Mr. Greene. And photostatic copies of the Congressional Record in which a United States Senator called your organization "THE STAR RACKET OF THE TWENTIETH CENTURY", that would have to be introduced in evidence. Wouldn't it Mr. Greene. And there are so many other documents which would have to appear, that somehow or other, I dont believe you dare file suit against me in Federal Court. I hope you do. I would give most anything to see you do that. But your attorneys have advised against it--haven't they Mr. Greene? They have told you that your McEldowney got himself out on the end of a limb when he openly attacked this religion, haven't they Mr. Greene.

Oh yes Mr. Greene--we know many things for we have been "walking by night" some of the time, digging behind the scenes. And we have discovered interesting documents which would have to be brought out in Federal Court, wouldn't they Mr. Greene?

Oh yes--and did you know Mr. Greene that in the last war we suffered ONE MILLION CASUALTIES, TWO HUNDRED AND FIFTY THOUSAND OF THEM BEING DEATHS, TRYING TO PROTECT THE RIGHT OF EVERY AMERICAN, INCLUDING ME,

NOT ONLY TO WORSHIP GOD, BUT TO TEACH THE WORSHIP OF GOD ACCORDING TO THE DICTATES OF THEIR OWN CONSCIENCE? And did you know Mr. Greene, we still have a very virile, potent, and righteous Constitution here in the United States? And did you know too Mr. Greene, that it is very un-American to try to dent any man the right to buy space in newspapers and magazines, as whiskey and cigarettes are allowed to buy space? And did you also know that to threaten newspaper publishers who insist on running our copy is very wrong too?

You know Mr. Greene, The Psychiana Religion, which your organization has tried so very hard to suppress, could very easily be the religion which is bringing to this earth, the pure unsullied truths of God? You will recall, Mr. Greene, when you suggested that I change my copy to read " I THINK I TALKED WITH GOD", what my reply was. I think you have a letter in your files Mr. Greene which tells you in no uncertain terms that not even your "investigators" are qualified to pass on the deep religious experience of any man. That letter came from a nationally known author and theologian--did it not Mr. Greene?

Well--this is about all for this bulletin Mr. Greene. There are so many other things I could say, but I'll save them for the present, hoping against hope that your attorneys, even if only to "save face", ~~bring~~ file charges in Federal Court against me for both slander and libel. If what I have said here Mr. Greene is not true, you have an open and shut case. But if what I have said here is true, your whole organization stands completely discredited before the world, as a subversive, un-American organization, financing itself through the monies received from business-men who do not know your real nature and character.
