Rest assured we will do all we can spiritually.



Or "Who was your favorite?" But He will ask, "What have you done with My Son?" You need not say, "I'll be neutral" I'll neither receive Christ nor reject Him." Pilate tried that, but failed. There was no middle ground. It was simply

#### CHRIST OR THE WORLD-WHICH?
