A Word To All Our Students

This country is at war. Our enemies are capable, brutal and have unknown numbers. They are cunning. They are religious fanatics. It will take the combined efforts of the Allied nations to bring them to their knees.

The "PSYCHIANA" Movement is strictly a religious movement. It teaches the Power and the ability of the Spirit of God to dethrone every force of evil. If this world knew of the existence of this amazing Power, there would be no war today—the whole world, instead, would be living in peace and harmony.

But this world does not yet know who or what God really is. It has been taught old theological theories which have little truth in them. So, until the glory of the knowledge of the Spirit of God is made known to all nations, what should be the attitude of Americans? There is but one answer to that. A divided America cannot win this war. So, regardless of our political affiliations, regardless of our religious beliefs, all who live in this fair land should do everything in their power to help this government win this war. If this country is not worth fighting for it is not worth living in, and my suggestion is that any able-bodied man who seeks deferment from military service through "conscientious objection," should get out of the country and try living under Hitler or the Jap for a while. We have no room for them here.
