WHEN this European war broke out, or rather, I should say, this revolution against everything that is noble and true, I immediately

started our machinery going in an attempt to offset and perhaps check the inhumane activities of the Chancellor of Germany. Hundreds of thousands of circulars opposing this sort of thing have gone through the mail and hundreds of thousands more will go out as fast as I can put them

Perhaps the one movement which looked out a lot of German parasites in this country was our "Spiritual Awakening." In this circular I asked straight-thinking Americans and some of my Students to throw the power of the Spirit of God against this European madman. Naturally, signed promises to do this came to us by the tens of thousands and these signed promises coupled with other literature have released lead me to suspect that in the present writing there must be considerably over 500,000 people in the United States who are actually and literally throwing the Power of God against this pseudo-humanism which time and tide have washed up on the shores of eternity. Very so often a letter has come in testing my attitude against Hitler and his ilk. Such letters are at once turned over by me to the Federal Bureau of Investigation in the nearest city to where the letters originated. If these letters come from Students, the enrollment is immediately cancelled.

I am reproducing here a letter which came in this morning from a student in New York City. I am omitting the name and the address. I think it advisable to give you a copy of his letter together with my reply to him and my letter to the Federal Bureau of Investigation so that my stand on the European situation may be fully known and so that our hundreds of thousands of followers may adopt the same attitude toward these ungodly forces as is

adopted by me. This thing in Europe is a direct challenge to every principle of right, freedom, and justice, which, of course, means God, and I do not intend to sit idly by and allow those forces to succeed when I know that it is completely possible for me to sit here in this study and direct enough of the Power of God against that man, Hitler, to bring his complete collapse. When hundreds of thousands of followers of mine do the same thing, his defeat is made all the more certain.

I have no bombing planes, no submarines, no flame throwers to use against this incarnation of the devil, but I have a weapon which is far more potent than anything Hitler has. He can destroy human bodies but that is as far as he can go. His actions are entirely and completely materialistic. This Movement, on the other hand, is a very definite revelation of the Power of God on this earth. As a matter of fact, it is the only Movement on the face of the earth through which the actual Power of the Spirit of God is being manifested in human lives. It is, therefore, my solemn duty to take a leading role in the efforts directed by nations and individuals to bring an end to the "hell-begotten" theories and actions of Adolf Hitler.

I want no one in this organization who has the slightest tinge of sympathy for that individual. I have repeatedly stated that if I discover one, his name will go off our roles awfully fast. There is a very solemn duty devolving upon every member of the "Psychiana" organization, for let it be remembered, first, last, and all the time, that the only interest I have in life is to do away with pagan superstition which masquerades as being of God, and replace that superstition with the literal Power which is God.

My advertising methods may be

open to criticism. That, however, is my business. They have been and still are very, very effective, and if I find a way in which I can arouse the

interest of American people in the truths of God, I shall use that method regardless of what criticism may come from any source whatsoever. In the final analysis, "the proof of the pudding is always in the eating," and the works accomplished by this Movement for God and humanity stand unequaled along the shores of time.

This work will not be fully understood or grasped until long after I am out of the picture. I am sowing the seeds—others will reap the harvest. Sometimes I think there is a possibility in these fast-moving times of my living to see the day when the whole world knows the Power of the great God-Realm. Be that as it may, however, I live from one day to another doing everything humanly possible in that day to raise the spiritual sights of men and women everywhere. Others have come before me who have tried to do the same thing. They were crucified for those efforts. Sometimes after they were dead and gone a monument was erected to them. I am not interested in any monuments. I am interested in gathering around me a group of people who will first find and know the invisible Power of the great God-Realm, and who will then stand with me in bringing this Power to the world.

Mr. Hitler hasn't the faintest opportunity of withstanding the Spiritual Power of this Movement. He may make a few more successes, but just as surely as the sun will set tonight, he will go down to a felon's tomb which will be too good for him. I prophecy the man will commit suicide, for undoubtedly he is insane, and I personally believe him to be a degenerate in every sense of the word. No true American who believes in God and who believes in American democracy can have the slightest respect for anyone who, regardless of

The Emptying Church . . .

I AM thinking today about the churches of Moscow, Idaho, and of every city and village in America. Here in this little city I believe there are 14 or 15 churches. The total population of the city is not over 6,000 people. You can put all the attendants every Sunday in the whole 14 or 15 church into two of them, and this situation exists all over the United States. Something must be wrong.

Travel through the country as I do, with spires on every hand, bells ringing every Sunday morning and Wednesday evening, and often two or four churches each on opposite corners; but they are unused. They are voiceless. They are empty from one week-end to another. About one-tenth of the pews are full on Sunday. In Moscow, Idaho, one church, or at least two, could look after all the "faithful" there are in the city. Unused churches—dead, voiceless, empty churches. This fair land is full of them.

What can we do about it? I think it safe to state that there are fifty times too many churches in America today. In any city of 50,000 people two Protestant churches are enough, yet you probably have from 50 to 100, each keeping its own "pastor," each teaching its own peculiar system of theology, and each separated from the other by creed, dogma, and ritual. One church would be enough.

Not long ago there swept across the American religious horizon the "Moral Rearmament Program." You don't hear much of it any more. Nor have we seen any moral rearmament as a result of it. The old world gets "wusser and wusser," in spite of the Oxford Group or any other group. This superfluity of churches gets larger, and the more churches stand empty, the faster does civilization go downward, for it is not possible to erect a solid structure of civilization and leave the spiritual foundation out of it.

We know that what these empty churches are teaching is not of God. We know that what we have as religion today is the same old thing the

pagans had down through the ages. We have the same fundamentals, the very same ordinances, and the same story of the "fall" of man and his subsequent "redemption" through some sort of blood. In the Christian philosophy, the Lamb of God enters into the picture. In the Mexican theology it is the Ram of God, and in another system of religion, of the dark ages, it is the Bull of God, all the same, though. Sins washed away by the shedding of blood. Sometimes a ram, sometimes a lamb, and sometimes the blood of a god is necessary.

In this article, let us leave out of the picture for the time being the efficacy and the truth or untruth of what these failing and emptying churches teach. Let us see if we cannot advocate something which may straighten out the mess "religion" has gotten itself into today. I suggest therefore, that a sort of Federated Church idea be brought in. Let's do away with 12 of the 14 churches in Moscow, Idaho, and let's do the same thing in every other city and hamlet in America, for something should be done.

Of course, what should be done is this—these good churches should first of all cast off these pagan traditions which they are teaching, and they should find the actual Spirit of the Living God, and then preach it. It will be quite some time, however, before they do that, but that is what they should do; and that's all they should do. If every denomination in existence were to throw away every creed, dogma and ritual, and stand on the fact of the present existence of the Spirit of God in the lives of all, there would then be no need of splits. There would be no need of 14 churches in Moscow, none of them able to pay their bills, and none of them able to bring men and women the priceless truths of the Power of the Spirit of God. If such were done, then Lutheran, Baptist, Holy Roller, Nazarene, etc., could worship in the same building and could all be refreshed by the Power of the Spirit of God.

Yet they won't do this. They will

quarrel and fight and rant and rave about this theory and that theory. One will say Saturday is the Sabbath and the rest of them say Sunday is the Sabbath. What difference does it make whether we have a Sabbath or not if all men know the presence of the Spirit of God in their lives every day of the week? Yet these religious crews will separate and divide and quarrel and rant about their respective doctrines. Each will build a different church, mortgaging it to the hilt, and after they have done and said all they can, not one single soul will have been brought into the knowledge of the Power of the Spirit of God in his or her life. The whole thing is ridiculous.

Then, of course, the Catholic church stands there and won't even let a priest go into the church of another denomination. He can, under certain circumstances, go into the basement or classroom of another denomination, but he cannot go into the pulpit or even into the main body of the church. Of course, to me, the Roman Catholic church is the greatest instrument of paganism and idolatry the world has ever known. I believe it to be the greatest stumbling block on the path of the Power of the Spirit of God this world has ever known. I do not say this with any desire to injure the faith of any. I say it because I believe it is true. It all tends to make the religious mess get bigger. I'm trying to straighten out the mess. I cannot do that with anything these churches teach. I can do it by and through the Power of the Spirit of God. Through the Power, these varying churches know nothing about. If they did, they would not care whether they ever saw a church or not, because they would be happy in the knowledge of the Spirit of God in them, every hour of the day, and through that Spirit they would let their light shine so that those who knew not God might be brought into the knowledge of the Spirit of God. As long as they are fooling around with an old pagan theory of "god in a cross," they cannot know the simple truth of "God in a human life."

The first thing then for the churches to do, is to get together on common ground. That ground should be

Questions and Answers

Q: I have filed a complaint against you today with the postal authorities as I do not believe your literature should be allowed to go throughout the country by the U. S. mails. They will probably put you where you belong, and where the only "suckers" you will be able to catch won't have any money. When you are there, remember who put you there.

A: This is not exactly a question, but I thought I would reply to it through this column. I am glad you filed your complaint if you believe that I have defrauded you through the mails. Will you please send me a copy of the reply you receive from the postoffice? I think if I were you I would spend my time and brains, if you have any, in trying to do something constructive for humanity in its present dangerous condition, instead of trying to hurt someone who is trying to help. However, the U. S. Postoffice Department is not very likely to make many moves on any complaint filed by you.

Q: You have stated on various occasions that no mention has ever been made of Jesus Christ outside of the four gospels. I am a minister of the Congregational denomination. I was taught in theological seminary that Josephus made a reference to Jesus at the time he was living on this earth. Did he or did he not?

A: He did not. The quotation you refer to has been exploded as a base interpolation by every bible scholar of note. No Jew would ever call Jesus "the Christ." Moreover, the verse you refer to is not to be found in the earlier editions of Josephus. It was placed there by a Christian writer in an attempt to prove the story of Jesus Christ—instead, it only proves the opposite. If Jesus Christ were actually God Almighty, this continual argument as to his actual existence could not be—it would be an accepted fact. The whole story of Jesus Christ being Almighty God is a base origination of the Christian church, and never has been proved. But even if it were a fact, what good did that birth do? What good can it do today? Can it bring this Hitler to his knees? Can it drive war from the face of the earth? Can it do one single thing to bring to this earth any Power which can help? I think not. When the church forgets completely the pagan theory of Jesus Christ, and when it finds in place of that absurd story—THE ACTUAL POWER OF GOD, then will that same church become the instrument through which God can speak to this world to its everlasting redemption. Until that time, God must speak through organizations entirely outside of the church.

Q: I cannot deny the logic of what you teach, nor can I answer your arguments—I believe you know what you are talking about. It is hard to conceive, however, that the whole Christian world is mistaken about God. How do you account for it?

A: Very easily. You said "the whole Christian world," and I'm glad you did, for the entire world is not Christian. How do you think 50 per cent more Hindus could be fooled than

Christians? They have the same identical story the Christians have, and they had it 1,500 years before. The fact that there have been more than 30 "crucified gods" in various religions is proof that at the bottom you will find one common origin of all these religions. The Christian religion is the most recent of them all, and they ALL originate in FEAR. The churches have told us that we were "BORN IN SIN AND SHAPEN IN INIQUITY AND WE STAND IN NEED OF THE CRUCIFIXION OF A GOD TO MAKE US WHOLE AGAIN." That theory of religion is a blasphemy on the name of the Infinite Creator of this universe. Had the very opposite story been told, and had man been taught that he is the greatest thing God ever made, with dominion over all the earth, what a different picture the world would present today. When God is given credit for knowing what he did when he made man, and when the human race recognizes the fact that ALL THE POWER OF GOD NOW LIES IN MAN, ONLY AWAITING THE CALL TO COME OUT, MAN AND GOD WILL THEN LIVE ON THIS EARTH TOGETHER. It is a pity that so many have been fooled by an honest but impotent church. The day is at hand when the whole world will know the Power of God. If I had your wealth, brother, I would give it all to the spreading of this Movement, for it is the only Movement on the face of the earth which KNOWS who and what God is, and is capable of bringing that knowledge to the rest of the world. Why don't you send us a check for \$100,000? You could if you wanted to help bring God to this world.

Q: Was there ever need for religion as we know it?

A: Decidedly not. If the actual truths of God had been brought to the world by the churches, it would be O. K. and the whole world would know God by this time. But "religion as we know it"—a thousand times—NO. The world would be better off if the "crucified god" story had never been told. A LIVING GOD is much better than one who was killed 2,000 years ago, and has never been heard from since. Two thousand years is a long time, and lots of blood is being spilt today while the "god" of the Christian has a good time "up in the sky." Let's put that sort of twaddle as far away from us as we can, and let's give the Great Spirit—God—credit for not ever leaving his creation, but for LIVING IN IT—EVEN NOW.

the provocation, will machine-gun and ruthlessly blast into eternity, innocent men and women. There can be no honor or credit due such ghastly happenings, regardless of what the result may be and the whole German nation stands today branded with the mark of the beast which mark will never be eradicated.

If there are any of my Students who are even sympathizers with Adolf Hitler, let them tell me who they are and I will strike their names off my list so fast that it will be pitiable.

This is not so much a battle between Hitler and England as it is a fight to the finish between the powers of right and the powers of wrong. The condition which exists today is the natural, normal result of a world gone mad. The reason the world has gone mad is because it has never known of the existence of the Spirit of God in human life. Religious organizations, honest, every one of them, and believing in the traditions of the

people, have informed their followers that the great Divine Intellect which brought the Life-Principle to this earth in the first place removed Itself from the human race and sits somewhere in the sky awaiting a favorable opportunity to return to this earth and "save it from sin."

They tell us that the great Creator of this universe, seeing the lost, hopeless condition of the man It created, came down to the earth and was born of a virgin and was killed on the cross only two thousand years ago.

I love and pity every religious institution which expects to save the world with any such philosophy as that. It isn't even philosophy, nor is it true. I fully realize that if I am correct in my statements, every existing religious organization which believes in the crucified god is teaching an erroneous doctrine. I make the statement unhesitatingly that this is a fact. For eleven years now I have been telling this world that the "Psychiana" Movement is revealing to men and women the truths of God. The churches, however, have ridiculed that statement. Such church periodicals as the Sunday School Times, The Gospel Advocate, Lutheran Companion have run wild, rabid articles in their respective newspapers against this Movement and myself, claiming of course, that they are the only ones who have any knowledge of the true God and they tell us that God Almighty was killed two thousand years ago on a cross and has never been heard from since.

I said a few paragraphs back that the reason these almost hopeless world conditions exist is because this world has never known God. I repeat that statement here and add to it the further statement that the religious philosophy which teaches that the great Creator of all things made such a mess of his creation that it took his own death on a cross to remedy things is a false philosophy, and the world should know that by this time. It is two thousand years now since the last of the crucified gods appeared, and if that conception of God is true, God might just as well have saved Himself all that suffering on that cross for the condition of the world today speaks eloquently

of the failure of that story to reveal God to mankind or to the human race.

Revolutionary? Of course, Movement is revolutionary. It has to be to bring a new picture of God to this world. But as the days and weeks go by, I see the results of our labor. I see the handwriting on the wall and let me say to every reader of this magazine that the day is very near when the true Spirit of God as the Spirit is being revealed by this Movement will usher in a day in which war cannot exist. Such men as Hitler will never be able to even live in this day, for the glory of the knowledge of the Spirit which is God shall cover this earth as the waters cover the sea.

ters come in, I turn them, complete,
over to the Federal Bureau of In-

From Groveland, California, comes this letter from Myrtle M. Deihl, and I believe you will agree with me that it is a wonderful letter. Try to imagine the good being done by this Teaching, when letters such as we reproduce here have been pouring into our offices for nearly eleven years now. What other religion on the face of the earth has ever duplicated this record? What other system of theology is there which is actually demonstrating the Power of God as we are? This lady has been a Student for years and, in her letter, she states that she has never before written us about her experience. The letter is too long to give in full, so I will take parts of it and give them to you:

"My experience is all so marvelous I stand aghast. I have no one to tell this experience to, so I am pouring it all out to you. The spiritual part of my experience far outweighs the other parts, for therein lies my greatest desires. I know that God is very real to me. May God continue to bless and prosper you."



Here is another cancer case which was cured by the Power of the Spirit of God. If anyone ever tells you that cancer is not curable, refer them to the many cases you will read of in the Weekly from time to time. It will amaze them as it does all of us, myself included. The letter is from Student Mrs. Adams—God bless her:

"One year ago this month a friend of mine was very sick with sarcoma (cancer) of the eyes, and was about to go to the hospital for an operation when she called me, as she had heard me speak of Dr. Robinson's Teachings. We talked for a while, then I asked her if she couldn't (if nothing more) just try to touch the hem of his garment. She said she didn't know how, but said that if she could only get enough eyesight to keep going around the house and do her housework. I told her she could and asked her if she wouldn't like for me to have the Lessons sent to her. She seemed very pleased. We wired you and your reply came asking her to "report recovery." I told her you were expecting a recovery or you wouldn't have wired that way. From then on she took a hold on faith . . . last night I paid her a visit and she had other visitors. During the conversation she was asked by these visitors about her eyes, and she said, 'My eyes are just fine. I don't believe I'll ever have any more trouble with them.' When I heard that, I was very happy, and am sending the report of the recovery to you."

These letters, telling of these remarkable cases are separated from the business mail and laid on my desk. As they are needed for the Weekly, I quote from them. hesitate to write about the war. It is really not a war; it is a world revolution, or rather an attempt at a world revolution by one who unquestionably is a madman. The reason I hesitate to write is because I do not know what will have happened by the time what I write reaches you. Unquestionably the whole world will be involved, and unquestionably those who love peace, justice, righteousness, and fair play will have to die in the fight if we want our lives to be secure. I consider one who talks pacifism now either a fool or a criminal—or both. When a madman attacks your home, you will fight; that is, if you are any sort of a man at all. I believe Americans will fight, not Europe's wars, but to protect this beloved land of ours.

There is one sure way to stop such madmen as Hitler, and that is for all of us who believe in a higher Power to unite in and through the strength of that Power. Try and suggest that to the different churches and see what they will tell you. The Catholic will tell you that no one can speak or teach for God" except that which the Holy Spirit will tell you. The Protestant will tell you that the Catholic is all wet. Ask the Methodist how about joining hands with the Baptist and see what he will tell you—they will get into a fight at once as to which is the proper method of baptism, sprinkling or pouring, or immersion. Little do they care if the "supremacy of baptism" is one of the oldest pagan rites known to man. They will fight over it and over other doctrines nevertheless.

When the churches of all denominations think more of the peace of the world, and when they think more of the Power of God than they do of their own organizations, then something can be done for the world. As it is now, none of these pseudo-religious organizations know anything about God, but you cannot get one of them to throw overboard the traditions, customs and rituals which separate and confuse them, even though the world might be brought to a knowledge of God if they would.

Religious tradition is a woeful thing. It has cost a lot of blood. More

than all the wars have cost. As a matter of fact, most of the wars fought have had religion at the bottom of them, just as this revolution has. Hitler is defying every principle of right, which means every principle of God. Naturally, God, or the forces of right, will win. But how much quicker would they win if these so-called "religious" organizations thought a little more of God than they do of their traditions? We shall see, however, what happens. I predict this man Hitler will carry everything before him up to the point where some man will arise and challenge him in the name of, and in the Power of, the Spirit of God. It will have to be some individual, for the churches will never help. They are sunk too deep in superstition, myth, and tradition. They will bring their own doom on their heads. May God pity and help them.

existence of the Spirit of God in the body of each. All else can go by the board, for the rest of it isn't worth arguing about. When they have all received the true facts of God, they then, if they care to, can dispense with 90 per cent of their churches. Let them pick out the biggest and the most comfortable, and let them open them up at six in the morning and close them at three the next

morning. Let them do that every day in the week. There are many other things they could do, but space forbids my going into them now. What I am trying to do is to first of all bring to the churches of all denominations the consciousness of the fact that what they are bringing to men and women as being of God, is nothing more or less than an old heathen superstition told again. With that, they will get nowhere. It is the sole reason for the fact that the churches are emptying. People have heard that story and they don't want it. They don't believe it. It does not ring true. It does not satisfy them. So they go away, and the church empties itself.

Will the churches ever do this? They may. Protestantism came into life because the Roman Catholic church was so rotten, and it surely was rotten those days. If the Protestant church gets as rotten as the Catholic church then was and now is, there is hope that all churches will experience a Spiritual Awakening, and through it may find and know, for the first time in their lives, the Power of the Spirit of God. I have hopes this will be done. It can be done. It must be done. Either that, or this "Psychiana" Movement will so spread that the Spirit of God, through it, will replace all churches, for the truths of God are far more powerful

than all churches. Not so long ago I was writing to a famous Roman Catholic gentleman who is a teacher at San Francisco Catholic university. In the letter, I stated something like this: "I am not as big as the Catholic church—I am not as big as the Protestant church—but I am as big as the Spirit of God." If the Divine Spirit of God is behind this Movement, as I don't think there can be any question about that, it will eventually bring to all mankind the truths of God, in place of the old heathen traditions which are now masquerading as those truths through the present day emptying churches.
