E of the greatest compliments ever paid "Psychiana" by another religion was paid in Boise, Idaho, on the 2nd this year when the Idaho Conference of the Methodist church denounced the "Psychiana" movement and its teaching.

The Associated Press dispatch reads:

BOISE, Idaho, June 2. (AP)—The annual Idaho conference of the Methodist church closed today with announcements of pastor assignments and a denunciation of 'Psychiana,' cult originated and taught by Frank B. Robinson of Moscow.

In a resolution, the conference censured 'teachings and activities of Frank B. Robinson' as contrary to Methodist doctrine and attitude. Further, the meeting disapproved of the association of any member with members of the Idaho annual conference with Robinson.

The session also expressed itself in support of conscientious objection to war."

This move was an aftermath of the appointment of Dr. C. W. Tenney as assistant director of "Psychiana" three years ago. It has rankled the Methodists ever since. Dr. Tenney gave more than 40 of the best years of his life to the Methodist church. He was president of two Methodist colleges. When the Gooding college was closed, in vain did Tenney importune the Methodist Conference to give him something to do. They refused. Then the Idaho Institute of Religious Education sent for Tenney, and after arriving here in Moscow, Tenney was informed that he would have to get out and rustle his own money. This was not what Tenney had brought to Moscow for, and he refused to do it, whereupon these teachers at the head of the Institute had no more use for Dr. Tenney. In

order to help him out, I released a letter to my Students some few years ago, and enough money was sent in to keep the institute in existence for another year. Finally, when it was quite evident that Tenney had to eat, I offered him a position in the "Psychiana" Movement, which he accepted.

For three years Dr. Tenney has faithfully answered letters from our Students, and he has quite a following amongst them. All this sat hard with the Conference, and pressure was exerted on Tenney, first to give up his \$6,000 bond on which he draws a pension of \$25.00 a month, and the threat used was dismissal from the Conference. Tenney practically told them to go south. This "castigation" of "Psychiana" is, in my opinion, the surest proof of the truth of our message. If the Methodist church O.K.'d what we are teaching, it could not be true; but whenever the Methodist church or any other church takes upon itself to pass resolutions condemning another religion, that's pretty good proof that the "other fellow" is getting under the Methodist hide.

I do not believe the Idaho Conference of the Methodist church is in any position to criticize the "Psychiana" Movement or any other religious movement for that matter. A recent issue of the Methodist Advocate discloses these startling figures, and I give here a comparison of "Psychiana's" achievements during the same period of time. In the past ten years 550 churches on the Pacific Coast (Methodist churches) decreased in Sunday School attendance from 551,927 to 471,350—a loss of 14.6 per

cent. In the same ten years, world service decreased from \$2,250,805 to \$863,106—a total decrease of \$1,387,699, or 61.6 per cent. Over that same period, pastoral support declined 12.7 per cent and *indebtedness went up 99.4 per cent.*

During those same ten years, the "Psychiana" religion went from scratch to eighth largest religion in the United States. In its first year it went into 67 countries, and today, in the United States alone, there are more than 12,000 cities, towns, and villages each having from one, to 25,000 Members. In addition to that, more than 200,000 unsolicited letters have come to this Headquarters, stating the fact that this number of people have found the Power of the Spirit of God, and have had their lives made happy by that Power. This Movement is the fastest growing religion in the world, and in the light of the above facts, I do not believe that the Idaho Conference of the Methodist church is in any position to criticize "Psychiana," and any criticism it may offer, under these circumstances, means just nothing at all.

I note the same conference O.K.'d "conscientious objectors," and again we differ. The "Psychiana" Movement requires every one of its Members to fight for these beloved United States, if danger approaches, and we have no room in our beliefs for any type of person who "objects" to defending America when the need arises. If the United States is not good enough to defend, it is not good enough to live in. The Founder of "Psychiana" has already offered his services, and he will give his own son any time to defend America. Sometimes what is conscientious cowardice attempts to hide its fear under the cloak of religion. Before this Movement would approve "conscientious objection," it would close down as a religious Movement. I think the Meth-

Wonderful Words - - - - -

TWAS a hard day at the office today—one of those days when everything seemed to come in at once. I don't believe I have ever seen a day when there were so many distasteful things to be done. Yet I smiled all day. However, the day was a very trying one, so when I arrived home this evening, little Florence took off my shoes and rubbed my toes, and got my slippers. Later, she and Mrs. Robinson and Alfred went out, leaving me here in the house alone. After resting for a little while (writing two articles for this magazine), I turned on the organ with nothing particular in mind to play. I just like to let my fingers wander over the keys, and before too long some old hymn tune comes into my head, and I play it. From that tune I wander to another one, and it is not unusual for me to sit there three or four hours at a time, playing these wonderful old melodies.

For some reason or other, the first tune to come to my mind tonight was "Wonderful Words." I played it about six times. You know the tune:

"Sing them over again to me,
Wonderful words of life;
Let me more of their beauty see,
Wonderful words of life."

After a little while, the thought came to me that I might write another article (while still resting) dealing with the subject of these wonderful words. Then the thought came to me: "where are my Students going to get these wonderful words from?" And I shall tell you in this article. In the first place, the life which knows God needs nothing or no one else to guide that life. God—the infinite Spirit of God, is the only Guide needed. There is absolutely no need to study any of the many bibles of the major systems of religion, for the "wonderful words" which come direct from the Spirit of God to us, are far sweeter and far more powerful than anything to be found in any bible.

There is a lot to be learned about the wonders of the Realm of the Spirit of God, as the Student soon finds out. On first thought, the new Student may read the Lessons and

think them simple. They are. But when he actually begins to contact the Realm of the Spirit of God, he finds out that these Lessons, while still simple, go down pretty deep into the God-Realm. If he masters them in one year, he is doing remarkably well. They took me over 40 years to assemble. But as one learns of the things of the Spirit of God, an entirely new Realm opens up. It is not a realm of spoken words; yet it is a realm of words. Spiritual words. Spoken in a spiritual language which takes a spiritual understanding to know, for what this communion actually is, is this—it is the Spirit of God talking or communing with you. You will recall that the "hidden" part of you—the unseen part of you—is God. Then, whenever you direct your thoughts inward, to God, you at once "tune in" and the Realm of the Spirit of God *outside you*, begins to commune with the Realm of the Spirit of God *inside you*.

In the meantime, you keep very still, very quiet, and allow the spiritual life which is in you to learn the wonderful words of spiritual life the Great God-Realm in its entirety speaks to you. And It speaks. And you hear. And you understand. "And He walks with me, and He talks with me, and He tells me I am His own, and the joys we share as we tarry there, none other has ever known." That's it. Just God and you. Spiritually speaking. You doing the listening while the Spirit of God speaks to the Spirit of God in you. Listening physically, I mean. Many people ask me why I ask my Students to keep quiet. Now you know. You are a combination of a physical body and the Spirit of God. You are both. When the physical is active, the spiritual is still there, only your mind is occupied with physical activities. Now the Spirit of God outside of you, speaks wonderful words of life to the Spirit of God inside of you. Therefore, it is quite necessary for you to have moments daily in which you "wait upon God" if you want to put it that way. You must ponder on the things of the Spirit, or you will not know the Spirit is working in you. I suggest

three times daily for communion with God. After a while you will arrive at the place where you live automatically and completely in the God-consciousness. Then you won't need these quiet periods, although you will think they always pay great dividends. If it should be that you will be called upon some day to lead a religious Movement, you will have known absolutely the Power and Presence of the Spirit of God in you outside of you. Then, those Spirits will be so merged in you that the complete Power of the Realm of God will be manifesting in and through you. You will still be subject to physical reactions of course, but *they will be the predominating forces in you*. Unless this is the case, you cannot perform any true work for either God or humanity.

But that merging your soul with the great Soul which is God, is a wonderful thing. Then you become part of God. Then God becomes part of you. Then it is that everything your heart and soul can desire shall be given to you. Then it is that you can "walk in the garden alone," yet you will not be alone, for the Spirit of God will be in your consciousness. It is possible, of course, for the Spirit of God to be in you; It is always in you, yet not in your consciousness. Now it is having God in the consciousness which counts. You have God with you always; but if you *keep the Spirit of God in your consciousness, and form every act of life with that consciousness and in that consciousness* then do you not see that it is not

Questions and Answers

Why does God allow this war to continue—why doesn't He stop it and why is it necessary for so many lives to be sacrificed before the True Light breaks?

God does not allow this war to continue—neither can He stop it until man will let him. The Infinite Spirit awaits now just the simple recognition of its Power, and men will then cease to fight and kill each other. This is a "Christian" war. The religious organizations on the earth have never known the Power of the Spirit of God. Therefore, they have been unable to bring that Power, or knowledge of that Power to others. Men and nations, having believed the church theory of God, had no chance to know the truth, not choosing to believe the church theory of a "crucified god," the nations believing there is no god, have tried to straighten the world out according to their own ideas. One nation feels that the other nation is in the way. So it tries to get it out of the way. God has nothing to do with that situation. When the real truths of God are known, and when men and women know those truths, they will lay down their own arms and see what fools they were to believe that anyone ever killed God on a cross. There is enough of the Power of the Spirit of God in this world to stop this conflagration overnight, but someone has to bring the TRUTHS of God to the world. The churches, with their "pagan" theory of God, certainly never can bring those truths, can they? All right then—THIS WAR WILL NOT CEASE UNTIL MEN AND WOMEN GRASP THE TRUE PICTURE OF GOD, which picture we are bringing to them just as fast as we possibly can bring it. I assure you we are not wasting any time here, nor am I sparing myself one little bit. It should take about two or three more years before men and women universally grasp the truths of God, casting aside all church theologies completely. Then, when that is done, there will be universal peace, for God will be known as He is.

So you are in the God-business, are you, you dirty low-down cur?

There accompanied this question a clipping from Mr. Pegler. Yes, I am in the God business. That's where I belong; that's where I shall stay. It's the only business I'm suited to, and I glory in it. I would not exchange places with the richest man alive, for the satisfaction I have through seeing men and women find God is joy enough for me. The last part of your statement I'm going to forget. You had better forget that you called me that. You might learn the truth some day, and be sorry you ever wrote it.

Do you ever expect "Psychiana" to grow real big? Can one man bring in a new religion which will really go places?

Every major system of religion the world has ever known was started by some one man. True, he had to be a man of vision, but religions are always started by the Spirit of God speaking to one man. If that man catches the vision clearly, a new

truth of God is revealed on the earth. God never speaks to more than one man in the same tongue. He never makes a revelation to more than one man at a time. You see, if you can't catch what God is trying to tell you, won't you?

Ques: What about the Psalms of David?

Ans: Some of the most beautiful things I have ever read. You don't find the name of Jesus in the Psalms very often—ever notice that? They deal with God. They are wonderfully inspiring. I like them.

Ans: The book of Esther. It's a mean book, too. Never should have been put in any "sacred writings."

Ques: Who answers these questions? Do you have someone else help you with them?

Ans: No. I answer them all myself, and I try to pick out the questions which I believe will help the most people for publication in the Weekly. We receive one hundred questions for every one answered here.

Ques: Suppose you are wrong, and you wake up and find yourself in hell, what then?

Ans: This question is asked many times. It always comes from religious fanatics, for the majority of Christians do not believe that foolish yarn any more. It dates back far beyond the inception of the Christian religion. No man in his proper senses can believe such tommyrot as that, in spite of the fact that the Christian bible teaches it. It is such teachings as these which have killed the Christian bible, and rendered the Christian religion impotent. People know the Christian religion teaches that stuff, and they do not believe it. The best thing the Christian religion could do would be to come out and publicly repudiate such asinine theories as these. It might save their religion.

Ques: I resent your attacking my religion, and shall take steps to see that you are stopped as you should be. I have depended upon the Lutheran faith all my life, and you have no right to say our faith is not true.

Ans: I have just as much right to say your story is not true as you have to say it is true—IF YOU CAN'T PROVE IT. You certainly cannot prove it. If your "faith" is untrue, and you try to teach it to others, and you do, I have the right, certainly, to tell those you are trying to "convert" that your story is not true. As far as your stopping this Movement goes, well, suppose you try it.

Ques: Have you been married more than once?

Ans: That's rather a personal question, but the answer is that I am still able to get along very nicely with the same wife, after 21 years of married life. I have had only one wife. Have you designs?

that doeth the works, but the Spirit of God which dwelleth in you? Now you have the secret of "Abiding in God." Not abiding in Christ, as the Chris-

tian would have you believe, for Christ, if he ever lived, died a long time ago and has never been heard from since. You cannot, therefore, abide in Christ. *But you can and must abide in God.* Now, the Christian says Christ was God, and here is where he makes his most fatal blunder. Christ was *never* God. He couldn't possibly have been God. I have shown why so many times that I shall not do it again here.

The Christian religion says *its* crucified god was really God. The followers tell us that Chrishna was truly God. Every form of religion having a "crucified god" tells us the same thing. Now, Christianity is but one of eleven major systems of religion. It is not the largest, nor is it a universal religion. Like all the rest of them, it considers its "man-god" to be Almighty God. There is no difference in any of their claims. But these claims cannot all be true. There could not have been 16 crucified gods, could there? The Christian story of its Christ stands on exactly the same level as the Hindoo story of Chrishna. Yet they each and all believe *theirs* to be the one and only God Almighty. That is where the Christian church errs so terribly. If the Christian church and the rest of the religions having "crucified gods" would push them all out of the picture, then the way would be wide open for them all to worship the only God this world ever did have—the *invisible Spirit of Eternal Life which is God, and which is the only God. There is no other God.* All these "incarnations" of "gods" are utterly absurd as not to warrant the passing thought of anyone capable of thinking. This is what I am driving so hard to accomplish. I want the Christian to see that any "incarnation" of Almighty God in a human being is foolish. So let the Christian lay aside that doctrine. It hasn't done a thing for God or humanity. Let him try doing what we are doing, teaching the invisible yet dynamic Power of the Spirit of God. If the churches of all denominations will do this, the Power which will come to them will stagger them. They will then be able to win this world for God in rapid-fire order. They will never do it as long as they have a "crucified god."

Knowing God

A prominent Presbyterian has just left my study. In the study is a recording device whereby I can throw a switch and register whatever conversation takes place. I thought it might be a good idea to throw the switch on the conversation this morning, thinking perhaps it might make interesting reading for the Weekly. The gentleman in question is a good fellow. He is a staunch Presbyterian, and an officer in a Presbyterian church. He came in to inquire about our "blitzkrieg for God," having heard about it through a letter from another city. I keep very quiet here in Moscow, and few people locally know what is going on. It's a case of a prophet not being without honor, save in his own country. Not that I want honor—I don't. All I want is to throw the actual Power of God against existing world conditions, and give that Power a chance to show what it can do. The conversation, as recorded, follows. I shall call my visitor "Mr. S.":

Mr. S. The Germans are at the gates of Paris—it certainly looks bad for the Allies.

Dr. R. Yes, and they may take Paris, but they cannot win this war.

Mr. S. Well, what do you mean? How do you think these Germans are going to be stopped?

Dr. R. They will be stopped because the motivating power behind them is wrong. Hitler is only the symbol of an incarnation of all the evil forces in the world today. The superior Power of right over wrong will bring the downfall of any wholesale murderer such as he. You see, Harry, the Spirit of God entails everything that is right, pure, noble, good, just, and peaceful. This man Hitler is not operating under the Power of the Spirit of God, but under the delusion that might makes right; therefore, don't you see, the Power of the Spirit of God, the Spirit of Right, being far more powerful than the spirit of wrong—he has to fall.

Mr. S. Well, Doctor, I understand you deny the divinity of Jesus Christ, and so do I for that matter; but how can you talk about the Spirit of God if you deny that Jesus Christ was God?

Dr. R. Harry, let me show you why I deny the story of Jesus Christ as being God Almighty. (Here I got out a list of 32 "crucified gods," all before Jesus Christ, and showed the list of these supposed "gods" to this gentleman. After showing them to him, in the traditions of other religions, I said): Now I want to know where all these came from, every one of them before the time of Christ, if the story of Jesus Christ is original and true. Here we have every fundamental of the Christian religion told in detail 1,400 years before the Christian religion was ever heard of, and I want to know why. Do you know what I think? I think the Christian story was stolen bodily by the Catholic church from the larger religion of the Hindoo, and I can prove that, I believe.

You have your virgin birth the 25th day of December. You have the virgins of the same name. You have the crucifixion, the resurrection, the ascension, and you have every fundamental of the Christ story 1,400 years before, and the names of the two gods are practically the same—Jesus Christ and Jeseus Chrishna. Now you want to know why.

Mr. S. Well, Doctor, this is all new to me, but don't you think there are very few people who believe that story any more?

Dr. R. True as can be; but, if the story is not true, *what have you to offer to take its place? The truths of God do not lie in that story, they must lie somewhere else, and that is exactly what I am teaching.* Do you know what the truth of God is, my friend?

Mr. S. Well, no, I really don't. I don't go to church; it's good for my business, and it's quite a relaxation after a busy week at the store.

Dr. R. Granted; but can you say even with your church membership, you know the slightest thing about the Power of the Spirit of God? Can you, and you, use that supreme Power in your everyday life? Are you not, as a member of a church, giving the lie to that membership?

Mr. S. Well, I know as much as I have been taught about God, but certainly God means nothing to me. Going to church means a lot, but I don't believe anyone really knows who or what God really is.

This conversation, which I terminate at this point, goes to show the attitude of the typical church member. I will grant you it is exercise and fine relaxation to be in a church every Sunday morning for an hour—no longer; but what you want to know is this: what good does that do if we do not know what God is, where God is, and if we cannot use the Power of the Spirit of God?

Two federal men were in Moscow, no, the other day, and they were going to a state official about my O.K. One of them said, "What has that fellow got—he's known all over the world, and they swear by him, but what has he got?" The state official lied, "You have to know the man to know that." Later, speaking to one of these men myself, he said to me, "You are the quietest man I have ever seen—how do you account for this quietness?" I replied that while many people look on me as being the biggest package of religious dynamite in this country, there exists under it all, a secret peace. And there is. When I'm alone, invariably my mind and spirit turn to God, and there, perhaps in study, perhaps in the country, perhaps in a hotel room, I look up into the face of God and renew my pledge to carry this message of Power to the ends of the earth. Every time I do that, I receive anew the assurance of the fullness of the Spirit of God in me. There wells up, and up, and up, that secret peace which often brings tears to the eyes. I cannot explain it. It is peace. It is the Spirit of God. That Spirit lives in me, and every move I make is guided by that Spirit. I can be dynamite—yes—and I can be dynamite to old pagan traditions of God; but the reason I can be so dynamic is because there is peace—under it all. The secret of whatever power I have is founded in Peace with God which passeth all human understanding. You may have this peace if you have it if you but know it. Look within you for God, instead of looking for Him on some mountain top or in the sky. You will find God where he is, and that's in you.

Hitler Knows

From correspondence recently received, I am of the opinion that Hitler is very well informed of the "blitzkrieg" the "Psychiana" Movement is conducting against him. Threats on our life become more numerous—that they worry me any, for Hitler is powerless against anyone who operates in and through the Power of the Spirit of God, and our Movement

operates through that Power. I would like to bet dollars to doughnuts that Hitler is more fearful of the Power we are throwing against him than he is of England. He knows, and he knows full well, that he is the greatest blight civilization has ever seen or known. He also knows that his doom is sure and close. So does his sidekick, Muscle-in-i, who, by the way, is about the smallest, most cowardly human being this world has ever known. He and Hitler are a good team. They will go down to defeat together.

Methodist church, instead of trying to crucify my Assistant, the Rev. Dr. C. W. Tenney, a member of the Idaho Methodist Conference, had better make sure it is filling a lack in this country at this time of national crisis. "Psychiana" is well able to take care of itself, and this resolution ill behooves any organization which operates tax-free, and then O.K.'s "conscientious objectors."

No religious organization in the United States should be given its property tax-free under the guise of religion, *unless such an organization can prove the truth of the statements it makes to the public regarding God.* We have nothing more than its own word that it is teaching the truths of God, and, when these same organizations O.K. "conscientious objectors," certainly, before they are allowed to hold their property tax-free, they should be made to prove their claims. There are others of us who don't want exception as "conscientious objectors," and we pay taxes. We can prove our story true, and Methodism should be made to do the same thing. One of these days I am going to open up a case in the Federal Courts, and seek to require that all religious organizations pay taxes as you and I do, or else prove the truth of their religion. Not a single one of them can do that, for no proof of their foolish story of God has ever been known to exist. The time has arrived for thinking Americans to demand proof of every religious organization, and if it cannot produce that proof,

it should be made to pay taxes like the rest of us. It should also be made to fight for the security of the United States along with others, until such time as it can prove its story. This business of holding property tax-free, and then refusing to defend the best country on the face of the earth, should be objected to by every clear thinking American, and it will be before too long.

I shall not say very much about this "resolution." I could reply bitingly through both press associations, but I won't; for, as I say, I consider it one of the greatest compliments "Psychiana" has ever been paid. On the same day on which the Methodists were passing resolutions against "Psychiana," which has no "conscientious objectors" in its midst, the United States made a memorable ruling against another religious organization which not only does not believe in fighting to protect American life and liberty, but which does not believe in saluting the flag either. The U. S. Supreme Court ruled that a school has a right to compel any student to salute the U. S. flag. Three cheers for the U. S. Supreme Court. I wonder if these Methodists who O.K. "conscientious objectors" would also oppose the saluting of the flag, or do they consider their duty to "Jehovah" above their duty to America. If they do, perhaps they had better go to Jehovah and look to the protection of Jehovah when their liberty is threatened.

This wonderful Light that you are giving to a darkened world—the Gracious Spirit in your Lessons, is very wonderful, but the last Lesson, No. 4, gave me a light and opened a way that I never knew existed.
